

# Hospital Patients being neglected Abnormal growth of unregistered clinics

**GOPALGANJ, Nov 29:** The unscrupulous owners of a large number of unregistered private clinics have been running their illegal business in the district for a long time which the local authorities concerned are allegedly aware of.

Most of these clinics have been set up allegedly by a section of government physicians who have been serving in different hospitals of the district and they are running their private business ignoring the government orders.

These physicians are found busy with their clinic business most of the time rather than paying attention to the hospital patients it is complained in the hospitals, residents alleged.

# About 2 lakh children to be vaccinated

**JHENIDAH, Nov 29:** One lakh ninety-nine thousand one hundred seventy five children age up to five years will be fed with polio vaccines and 1,70,366 children aged between one and five years will be fed with vitamin A capsule on December 8 this year on the occasion of third National Immunisation Day (NID) in Jhenidah district, according to District Civil Surgeon office sources said.

Sources said, 48,040 children in Jhenidah sadar thana, 37,621 children in Saikupa thana, 29,699 children in Kaliganj thana, 18,195 children in Kotchandpur thana, 45,121 children in Mohespur thana and 19,648 children in

Harinakundu thana including five pourashaba will be fed with polio vaccines.

When contacted Dr Sardar Badruddin, Civil Surgeon Jhenidah, said that 1,785 vaccination centres will be opened and 8,925 volunteers are being trained to make the third NID programme a success.

The Civil Surgeon informed 2,06,567 children were given polio-vaccines while 1,74,098 children were given vitamin A capsules during last NID.

He also informed that the Health and Family Planning (H&FP) Department workers have been campaigning to grow awareness among the people to ensure service to the people.

# Two convicted for kidnapping, raping girl

**KISHOREGANJ, Nov 29:** Two persons were convicted for kidnapping and raping a minor girl in a judgement delivered on November 17.

Of them, Ayna Mia was awarded life term while Mahabbat Ali (aliasconding) was sentenced to suffer RI for ten years and to pay a fine of Taka 5000 or in default to suffer RI for six months more. The court also found Ayna Mia guilty under another section and sentenced him to suffer RI for 10 years with a fine of Taka 5000 or in default to suffer RI for six months more. Both the punishment of Ayna Mia will continue concurrently.

The prosecution story in brief is that on October 24, 1995 at about 10 am, Asma Khatun, daughter of Abdur Rashid of village Kabir Kandan in Austagram Thana and a student of a local primary school was kidnapped by the accused while she was on way to the school. They took her forcibly to Kishoreganj town and then raped her in a room of a hotel.

A case was registered with Austagram police who after investigation submitted charge-sheet against them.

Md Maznun Ahasan, Additional Session Judge, Second Court of Kishoreganj district delivered the judgement.

# Smuggled goods seized

**BRAHMANBARIA, Nov 29:** Bangladesh Rifles of 23 battalion seized different smuggled goods worth Tk 81,600 from Ramchandpur areas on Monday, reports UNO.

The contrabands included Indian wine and a bicycle. The goods were deposited with the Akhaura Customs godown.

Meanwhile, Brahmanbaria detective police seized smuggled Indian carpets and sarees worth Tk 81,000 from Shahi Islampur canal area in Sadar thana last week.

Acting on secret information, detective police raided the area and recovered 10 bags of Indian carpets and sarees.
