The young striker was handed the sentence after smashing into the car of Rotterdam Theatre director Maarten Putman. 56, in September 1995 as the latter was leaving a parking space. Putman died of his injuries and his wife was injured.

Kluivert, uninjured in the crash, which also saw him have his driving licence withdrawn for 18 months, has already done 80 hours of community work, according to the Daily De Telegraf.

His lawyer said the player had resolved to "roll up his sleeves" and accept his punishment, which includes giving up his free time to carry out small repairs in homes for the aged.

Fowler also warned the rest of the league that Liverpool are back to their best.




