**Preview of Adity's papier mache exhibition held**

The preview of Adity Chakravarti's solo papier mache exhibition was held at La Gallerie in the city yesterday.

Adity has taken sheets of newspaper, and given them a life of their own.

Moving away from conventional fashionable bowls and boxes, Adity has created something new with her combination of sculpture and painting. The print in the newspaper has sometimes been retained to form an intrinsic part of the composition. Many of her creations have humour underlying the conception, while a great deal has been left to the imagination. The artist has also used the concept of masks from Indian folk art. Flat colours with flamboyant glaze have been used as finishing.

The artist studied commercial art and, later, trained in painting in Beijing under Xue Shiqu of the China Academy of Fine Arts. Adity has held exhibitions in Beijing and New Delhi.
