



people conscious of traffic laws: Anwar Communications Minister

Anwar Hossain yesterday said people should be made conscious of traffic laws through publicity by mass media as well as including it in the curriculum at the school and college levels, reports BSS.

He identified inadequate traffic system, tendency to break rules, little knowledge about traffic laws, narrow roads, different types of transport and, above all, migration of population from rural to urban areas as the main causes of traffic congestion in metropolitan areas.

The minister was speaking as the chief guest at a seminar on "Traffic congestion and transportation problems in Bangladesh," organised by Dhaka Chambers of Commerce and Industry (DCCI) in the auditorium of DCCI.

Presided over by Ali Hossain Hassan, President of DCCI, the meeting was addressed, among others. Afsar Uddin Ahmed Khan. State Minister for Public Works Dhaka Metropolitan Police Commissioner AK Al Mamun, and Bangladesh Road

Transport Association Chairman AN Hussain.

The minister said, traffic congestion has become a serious problem for all of us, and even to the foreign investors. The present government has declared the year 1997 as "investment year and it has pledged to develop the transport and communication sectors. "Our resources are limited,

but we have so many problems. including transportation. So we should first properly identify the problems of transportation and to develop the entire traffic system" the minister added.

The minister observed that traffic jam is also prevailing in different developed countries but what we face in Bangladesh is "traffic anarchy". He sought cooperation from all concerned people, including business community in this regard.

State minister for Public Works Afsar Uddin Ahmed Khan said, the entire city roads should be planned, number of traffic police should be increased, the number of overbridges, fly-overs and underpasses should be increased.

CPA's container handling programme hits snags

Star Report

The Chittagong Port Authority's (CPA) programme for upgrading its container handling facilities is suffering a setback because of unnecessary delay in decision-making. according to official sources.

The CPA had initiated the procurement process of Fork Lift Trucks (FLTs) as far back as April 1996, but it has hit snags when questions were raised about the performance of one particular machine supplied in 1995, which is also a contender in the port's acquisition of new FLTs, port authority sources

A committee was formed earlier to review a comparison table made earlier to highlight the performance of FLTs supplied by two separate manufac-turers — one from Finland and the other from Italy.

The comparison study was initiated in a special Board meeting on November 7 following the break down of the FLTs manufactured by Fantuzzi of Italy, which was reported in The Daily Star.

The study found that during the first one year of operation of the FLTs of both the companies, the Italian ones operated on an average 2900 hours with 35 defects while the Finnish machines operated for 1480 hours on average with 15 de-

ken down FLTs, it was also revealed that the company had parts and components that do not fit in the machines supplied to CPA, CPA reports point out.

Meanwhile, the CPA has initiated procurement of 10 more FLTs to ease the container congestion at the port. The same Italian company is now vying to win the contract.

Kong and Sri Lankan port operators reported adverse performance while two other overseas organisations in Singapore and Malaysia stated satisfactory performances, a senior CPA official said.
