Poet Shamsur Rahman, Prof Kabir Chowdhury, Prof Zillur Rahman Siddiqui, Mahabub Uddin Ahmed, Advocate Didar Ali and parishad general secretary Dr S A Malek also spoke on the occasion.

One minute's silence was observed in memory of the martyrs of the Liberation War, the father of the nation and his family members, the four central leaders killed at the Central Jail and those who were killed in their bid for establish-

ing democracy in the country including the founding president and founding general secretary of the parishad Dr Abdul Matin Chowdhury and Khondaker Mohammad Ilias.
