Vice Chancellor of Dhaka University Prof Abul Kalam Azad Chowdhury yesterday called upon the women community of the country to come forward to educate themselves for establishing a prosperous society, reports BSS.

He was addressing the Begum Rokeya Memorial Gold Medal and Scholarship distribution ceremony at Rokeya Hall of Dhaka University yesterday.

A discussion, organised by Bangladesh Nari Mukti Sangsad was held at the Workers Party office in the city yesterday in memory of Begum Rokeya, said a press release.

BSS adds Nated educationist Dr Nileema Ibrahim told that Begum Rokeya had always opposed the subservient role of the womanfolk challenging the then male-driven contention that higher education for women would bring deviation in the traditional norms of society.

Prof Majeda Saber, in her key-note paper, said Begum Rokeya criticised the women for their longing for ornaments and luxury leaving aside higher education which would lead them to the path of wisdom and greater emancipation.

Tk 397 cr frozen shrimp exported in five months

KHULNA, Dec 9: About 108,000 hectares of land will be brought under shrimp projects here during the current season beginning from January next, concerned sources said today, reports BSS.

Frozen shrimps worth Taka 397 crore were exported to several countries during the past five months ending November last.

The sources said that production of shrimp during the season could not be estimated correctly because of uncertain weather and other unforeseen circumstances.

Twenty-two frozen food plants are engaged in exporting shrimp through Mongla Port to Japan, Germany, China, United Kingdom, Belgium, Denmark and UAE, the sources said.

Shrimp projects owners said that they could almost double their production when some facilities like electrification of shrimp project areas, security for shrimp fry collectors in the remote sea, preventive measures against diseases of shrimp, bank loan for shrimp project owners, construction of dams in the project areas to save the projects from the onslaught of tidal surges and training for shrimp culturists are extended.
