Engineering Directorate enlisted all projects pre-qualified & Khulna Zila Parishad enlisted qualified contractors subject to proper compliance of the undermentioned terms & conditions for implementation of the undermentioned 2 (two) projects in 1 (one) package at Terokhada thana of this district under "Integrated Food-aided Rural Development Project (GCCR)" during 1996-97 financial year.

- 1. Qualified contractors or their appropriate representative can buy tenders for the projects at the prescribed price (non-refundable) from this office & offices stated at serial No. 2 up to 21-12-96 during office hours. Original registration book must be produced at the time of buying tender schedule.
2. Tenders for the project will be received in the box kept at this office as well as Project Director, Integrated Food-aided Rural Development Project (GCCR), Mohammadpur Housing & Pisciculture Society, Plot No. 50, Block-A, Shyamoli, Dhaka; Commissioner, Metropolitan Police, Khulna; Executive Engineer, LGED/Satkhira/Bagerhat & Thana Engineer, Terokhada offices simultaneously up to 1-00 PM of 22-12-96, and the tenders received will be opened on the same day at 01-30 hours before the tenderers (if any) present.
3. Earnest money of the tender should be deposited with the tender in the form of Bank Draft/Pay Order from only the scheduled bank stipulated by Bangladesh Bank in favour of the undersigned. Tender with Bank Draft/Pay Order from unscheduled bank or finance investment company will be treated as cancelled outright. 7.50% (seven point five zero) money will be deducted from the bill of the contractor and kept as security deposit against the work.
4. Rate of tender should be quoted above or below in overall percentage together on all items. Rate quoted should be written in words & figures. If the rate written in figures is illegible, then only the rate written in words will be considered. No cancellation, erasing or overwriting is admissible while writing rate and tender with cancellation, erasing, overwriting in rate will be treated as cancelled forthwith.
5. Tender submitted quoting rate more than 5 (five) per cent below will be cancelled outright.
6. If tender is submitted quoting rate more than 5 (five) per cent above, then itemwise rate analysis must be submitted. Tender without rate analysis or with photo copy of rate analysis or any cancellation/erasing/overwriting in rate analysis will be treated as cancelled forthwith.
7. Time of implementation should be treated as an important matter. Work of project must be started within 7 (seven) days of issuing work order & all finished within the prescribed time according to specification, failing which earnest money will be forfeited & Work Order cancelled.
8. Each contractor participating in the tender, must attach VAT Registration Certificate (attested copy) as per rule 15 of VAT Act 1991 with the tender, otherwise the tender submitted will be cancelled. If the tender is approved, then later on the original copy of the VAT registration certificate shall have to be produced.
9. Tender submitted in Form No. 2911 will be treated as 1st & formal. No formal tender will be received from approved tenderer. However, if required, in case of negotiated rate between the contractor & the authority, formal tender should be submitted prior to work order.
10. In view of implementing works of each phase stated in the tender schedule, work plan should be submitted with the tender. Tender submitted without work plan will be treated as cancelled outright.
11. If Departmental/salvaged materials are used in project work, then Income Tax & VAT will be deducted on the basis of gross bill amount including the value of that goods.
12. Construction materials to be used stacked at the site of work can only be used in work after test & approval from this office and the test fee should be borne by the contractor concerned.
13. Prior to submitting tender the site of work should be inspected & examined. Later on no claim as to difficulty in carrying goods, rain or cost/additional cost of underground water draining & ring dam construction can be made; such claim, if made, will not be considered under any circumstance.
14. Additional terms & conditions and technical rules & regulations with tender form are integral part of original tender. Other terms & conditions of tender can be known & seen during office hours.
15. If more than one tender quoting the same (lowest) rate are submitted, then lottery will be held on 28-12-96 at 11-00 AM at this office before the contractors present.
16. The authority is not bound to accept the tender quoting the lowest rate and may reject any or all tenders without assigning any reason. This notice is a brief one, and details may be known & seen during office hours.
