BCL-JCD clash, five injured

From Our Correspondent JHENIDAH, Dec 18: At least five persons were injured in a clash between the activists of Bangladesh Chhatra League (BCL) and Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) at Kibirpur Shahid Minar premises in Saikkupa thana Tuesday morning.

According to witnesses, the clash originated when both the groups faced each other while placing floral wreaths at the Shaheed Minar at about 9 am.

12 shops gutted in Pirojpur

From Staff Correspondent BARISAL, Dec 18: At least 12 shops were burnt to ashes in a devastating fire at the Kalkhali thana headquarters of Pirojpur district Sunday noon.

Witnesses said, the fire originated from an electrical short circuit and engulfed within the nearest shops of stationary, grocery, cloth, musical instrumental and others. Wealth of more than 50 lakh taka were gutted, they said.

Space constraint at godowns may affect Aman procurement drive

BOGRA, Dec 18: Shortage of space in the government godowns may hamper the aman procurement drive in the northern districts during the current season, official sources apprehend, reports UNB.

They said there are one silo, three CSD and 167 LSD godowns in the 16 northern districts having a total capacity of 3.50 lakh metric tons of food grains.

Already 3.27 lakh metric tons of grains remained stored in the godowns, leaving very little space to store additional foodgrains during the current drive.

The local authorities sought permission to transfer 1.44 lakh metric tons of grains elsewhere but the Food Department allowed only 37,000 metric tons.

Some 17 lakh hectares of land were brought under the aman cultivation in the northern region during the season

and there was bumper production.

The government has announced the target of purchasing one lakh metric tons of paddy directly from the growers. But officials were reluctant to purchase all the paddy brought in by farmers.

Paddy is being sold between Tk 150 and Tk 190 and rice is being sold between Tk 290 and Tk 320 per maund which are below the production cost. The government purchasing rate of paddy is Tk 251 and that of rice is Tk 392.90 per maund.
