## Naripakha urges govt

## Resolve problems of Bangladeshi workers in Malaysia

Naripakha, a leading women organisation, Monday urged the government to immediately resolve the problems of Bangladeshi workers facing deportation from Malaysia due to lack of legal documents, reports UNB.

Officials of Bangladesh Embassy in Kuala Lumpur are not cooperating with the workers trying to obtain legal documents or renewal of their passports, alleged the leaders of Naripakha at a press conference at the Jatiya Press Club.

Naripakha Convener Nasrin Haq addressed the press conference. Executive Director of Ain-O-Salish Kendra Hamida Hossain also spoke on the occasion and described the prevailing situation facing the Bangladeshi workers in Malaysia.

Nasrin suggested that the Bangladesh Embassy should remain open everyday from 7 am to 10 pm to provide all undocumented Bangladeshi workers with new or renewed passports which is a must for them to stay in Malaysia.

Malaysian authorities earlier announced an amnesty to the undocumented workers so that they could collect legal documents from their respective embassies for regularisation. The amnesty expires on December 31.

Hamida Hossain urged the government to negotiate with the Malaysian government on an emergency basis to extend the amnesty period as it seems impossible for thousands of workers to collect their passports and other necessary documents before the deadline.
