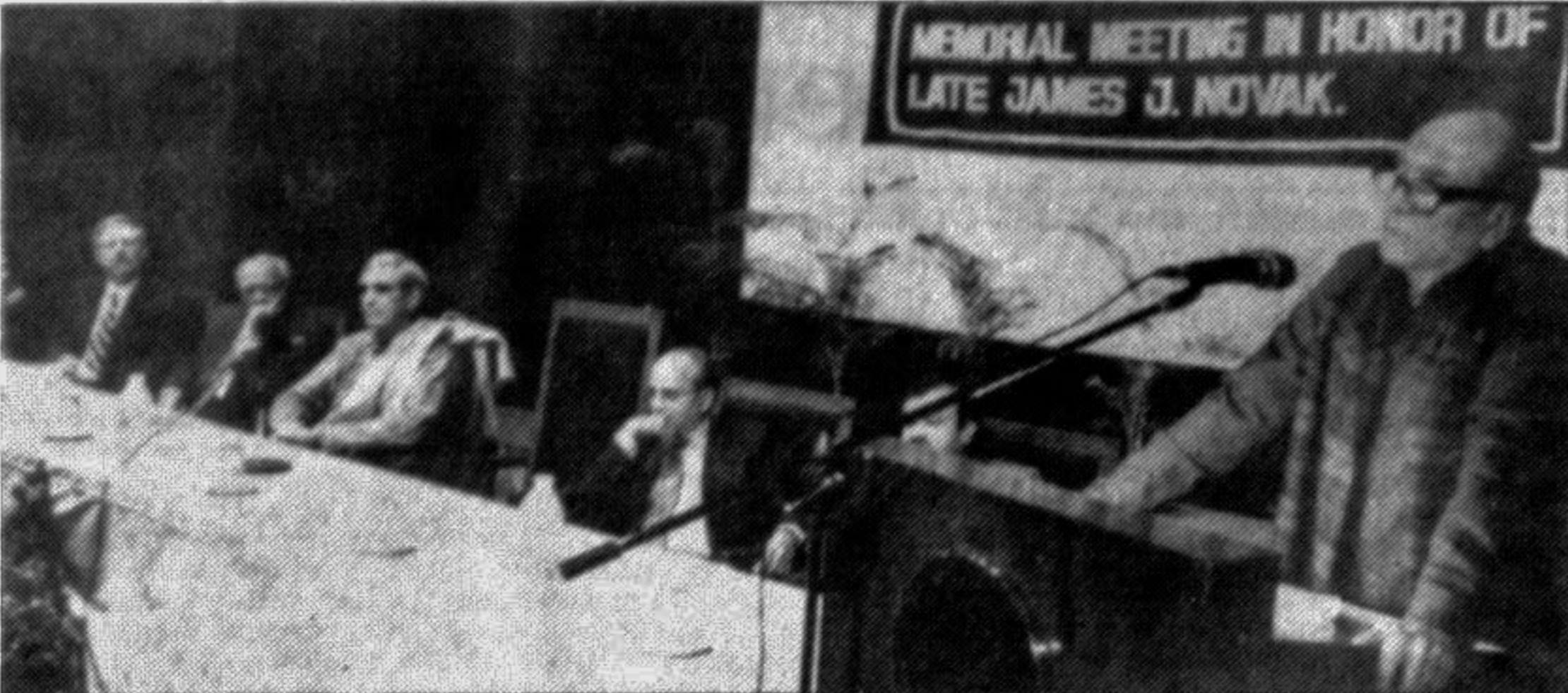

The areas where there will be no power supply in the same hours on today and Tuesday are: Uttara Sector-5 and on Tuesday at Hazaribagh road, Badda Nagar, parts of Motijheel commercial area and BUET area including halls. People at Kakrail, Circuit House, New Elephant road lane by lane will not have power supply during the same period on Wednesday, says a PID handout.

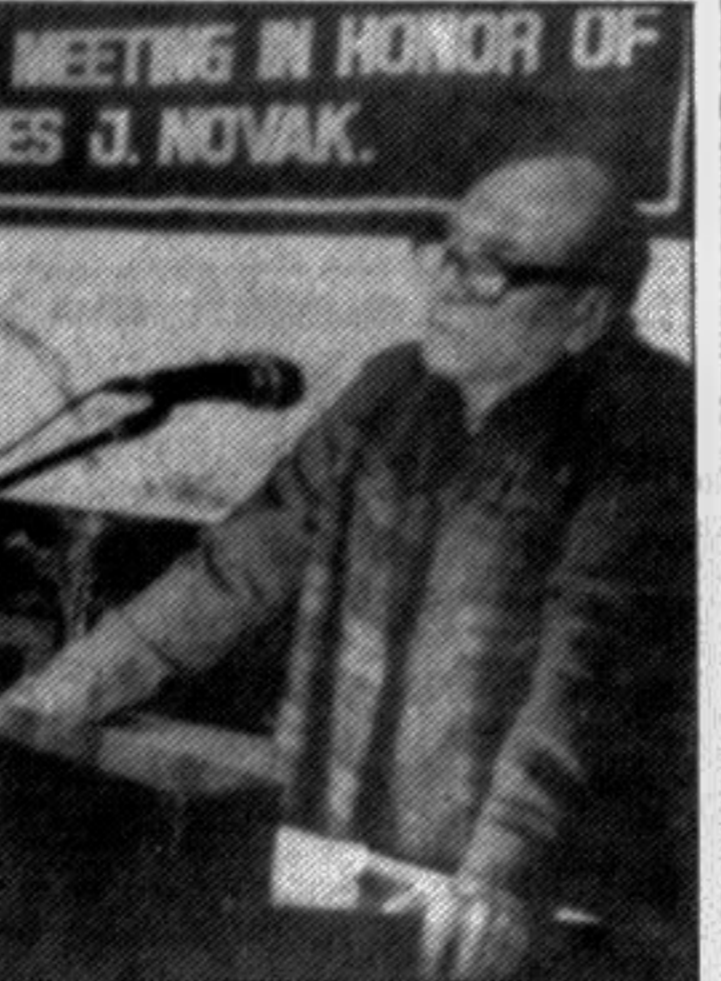
