Time for depositing Hajj money extended

The government has extended the time limit for depositing rest of the Hajj money under government management upto next January 15, reports UNB.

The deadline has been extended after receiving requests from some Hajj pilgrims and some other quarters said and official handout yesterday. "This time limit will not be

extended further," it added. According to the earlier announcement, the Hajj pilgrims who had deposited advance house rent of Tk 16,000 to particular banks for performing Hajj, had been asked to deposit rest of the Hajj money of Tk 62.815 to the bank by December

For detail information, the Hajj pilgrims have been asked to contact their respective bank offices, Deputy Commissioners and Hajj office.
