



King has come under mounting pressure in recent month, though the governing body's newly-elected president Terry Dwyer paid tribute to him in a statement.

He said King had overseen significant changes in the sport including the establishment of the Grand Prix series and the allocation of the International Amateur Athletics Federation (IAAF) Grand Prix meeting to Australia.

SAO PAULO, Jan 1: Kenya's Olympic 10,000 metre silver medalist Paul Tergat won the 72nd running of the Saint Sylvester Corrida over 15km here on Tuesday to retain his title, reports AFP.

Tergat, 27, finished in a time of 43 minutes 50 seconds, failing to endanger his record set last year of 43mins 12secs, beating compatriot Joseph Ki-

mani by 33 seconds. Vanderli Cordeiro de Lima of Brazil gave the home fans something to cheer about coming in third over a minute behind Tergat.

Mexico's Germain Silva, dual winner of the New York Marathon in 1994-95, took fourth place stealing it from his compatriot Benjamin Paredes in the final sprint to the line.

PERTH, Australia, Jan 1: South bizarre 2-1 victory over Switzerland in the Hopman Cup mixed teams tennis

championship on Wednesday despite failing to win a set, report agencies. Marc Rosset, apparently on the verge of a singles victory over Wayne Ferreira that would

Swiss, suffered a painful back

injury and was forced to with-Rosset was leading Ferreira 6-0, 2-0 when he collided with a ball girl as he chased a ball into the tramlines at the net. He tumbled and landed heavily. immediately clutching at his

The Swiss player completed the game after being given a pain-killing injection, but grimaced in pain at the change of ends and said he was unable to continue.

Ferreira automatically won the singles 0-6, 1-2 on default and the South African pair took the mixed doubles by forfeit after Rosset's injury failed to respond to treatment.

Teen ace Martina Hingis had earlier given Switzerland a 1-0 lead with an emphatic 6-1, 6-2 win over Amanda Coetzer, lifting her singles record in Hopman Cup play to 6-0.

Former Olympic gold medal-ist Rosset suffered a back injury on the way to Australia from Europe, and was unable to play his opening singles against Romania, although he did play in the mixed doubles as the Swiss scored a 2-1 victory.

His back was not giving him any trouble Wednesday and he Africa scored a romped through the first eight games, serving and volleying superbly. "I was getting my butt

kicked." Ferreira said. "He was killing me, so it is really sad for him. He's a good player, particularly when he's serving as well as he was today."

It is the second successive year in which Rosset has been involved in an injury drama at the Hopman Cup. Last year he broke a bone in

his right hand after punching an advertising hoarding in the final against Croatia. He was forced to withdraw and the injury also kept him out of the Australian Open.

He forfeited his opening singles tie to Romania's Adrian Voniea on Monday, but managed to play the mixed doubles with Hingis to secure a 2-1 vic-

Rosset had said his goal in 1997 was to make it through the year injury-free after a wretched run which saw him suffer a broken foot in 1995 and a broken finger last year. Tournament director Paul

McNamee said he was unsure whether Rosset would be fit to play in Switzerland's last group match against Germany on Friday, but was confident he would be okay for next week's Sydney tournament and the Australian Open.

The new injury was a blow for his teammate Hingis, who was in peerless form against Coetzer.

"I had a very good match with almost no mistakes," Hingis said. "It hit just about

"I think the Olympics were a lot more important to the women this year." Davenport, of the United States, said. "It was disappointing on the men's side that more of them didn't take it more seriously."

"Not everything to do with tennis revolves around making money, some of it is just representing your country and being with some of the greatest athletes in the world.

Davenport was speaking at White City, where she was practising just hours after arriving in the country for the Sydney International, which starts on Sunday, and the Australian Open.

While most of the leading women played in Atlanta, gold medalist Andre Agassi was one of the few top 20-ranked men to

"I don't know why the men don't take more time to compete in it. I thin its a goal of every American to be in the Olympics," Davenport said.
