Leading environment experts yesterday suggested a broad-based education programme for the people of all strata on environment protection side by side the development efforts in the country, reports BSS.

They said the media, particularly the electronic one, could be used more realistically for educating the people on how to take care of the environment around them.

Referring to the historic water treaty signed between Bangladesh and India and subsequent release of Ganges water through the Faraka Barrage to the river Padma, the experts said strategies should now be evolved on how this water could be conserved and used for various development purposes.

They were taking part in a discussion on "Conservation and improvement of environment in Bangladesh: Situation and prospects" at the auditorium of Bangladesh Unnayan Parishad (BUP), a non-government multidisciplinary research organisation, in the city yesterday.

Razzak tells newsmen

Govt may set up reservoirs for utilisation of Ganges waters

Water Resources Minister Abdur Razzak has said the government is contemplating making reservoirs in the country for effective utilisation of the shared water from the Ganges, reports UNB.

The minister disclosed the plan while exchanging views with newsmen at a city hotel yesterday on the Ganges water-sharing treaty signed with India last month.

Referring to the suggestions of the intellectuals, politicians and journalists, Razzak lauded their vital role in resolving the staggering water-sharing problem with India.

Termining the 30-year water treaty as a historic one, he said it stood as a landmark in consolidating friendly relations with India.

Under the terms and conditions of the present treaty, Bangladesh will share 35,000 cusec water in the dry season, he told the newsmen.

State Minister for Information Prof Abu Sayeed, members of parliament Harunur Rashid, Mujibur Master and Prof Khaleida Khanom were present on the occasion.
