Mother of nine murdered, another woman violated

SATKHIRA, Jan 10: A housewife, mother of nine children, was allegedly killed by her husband here recently, police said, reports UNB.

Family sources said the brutal husband Shamsuddin of village Panta in Kaliganj thana picked up a quarrel with his wife Aisha Khatun, 54, and at one stage he hit her with an iron rod killing her on the spot.

A case was filed with the police. The body was sent for postmortem. Shamsuddin went into hiding after the murder.

Another report adds: A woman age about 22, of Babnagar in sadar thana was violated by some miscreants on Monday night.

Family sources said the miscreants kidnapped her by force from her house and took her to a nearby beef and violated her one after another.

700 grams of heroin seized

MYMENSINGH, Jan 10: A special squad of the Narcotics Control Department seized 700 grams of heroin from AB Guha road in the town and arrested three people in this connection on Wednesday night, reports UNB.

Acting on a tip-off, the squad ambushed in a roadside jungle since morning and nabbed Dulu Hossain, Jamaluddin and Shahabuddin alongwith the drug at about 9 pm. All of them hailed from Ahori village in Trishal thana.

Bus owners threaten strike

Kazirhat — Natakhola road construction demanded

PABNA, Jan 10: At the annual

general meeting of the Pabna Motor Owners' Group held on December 31, the transport owners of Pabna unanimously passed a resolution demanding immediate construction of Kazirhat-Natakhola Ghat Road and widening of Nagorbari-Natakhola Road for removing the hurdles on the way of loading and unloading of ferries and plying of vehicles.

Presided over by Baby Islam, the meeting warned that they would be compelled to stop the bus and truck services between the two wings of the country.

If the recalled here in this connection that although the Ferryghat was shifted to Natakhola from Nagorbari, no approach road from Kazirhat to Natakhola, covering only 2.5 kilometers in length, was as yet taken up. The riverside road from Nagorbari to Natakhola was also too narrow and weak.

Moreover, the resolution demanded construction of a terminal and police camp at Natakhola without any further

delay.

The meeting also passed several other resolutions in the interest of the transport owners and workers.

The meeting also elected new office bearers of Pabna Motor Owners' Group at the election meeting held under the presidentship of Gaunesh Chandra Ghosh. The election was held unanimously with the following as its office bearers and members.

Two outlawed partymen killed

KUSHTIA, Jan 10: At least two activists of underground Biplobi Communist Party (Huq Group) were killed on Monday night by unknown assailants and police recovered their bodies from a field under Kumarkhali thana, reports BSS.

Police sent the bodies to Kushtia General Hospital for autopsy.

According to police, the activists are: Mohammad Ali Biswas alias Mama and Sakimuddin alias Kanu of village Mulgram under Kumarkhali thana.

1,298 crimes in Pabna in 9 months last yr!

PABNA, Jan 10: At least 1,298 crimes were committed in nine thanas of the district last year, police said, reports UNB.

The crimes included 35 murders, six dacoities, 14 highway robberies, 124 burglaries, 117 thefts and other crimes. Of the dead, seven people were killed in political violence.

Meanwhile, police recovered 9 fire arms, 3,213 rounds of bullets and a huge quantity of hand bombs during the period.

BCL sweeps Khulna Mohsin College polls

KHULNA, Jan 10: The election of the students' Union of Hazir Mohsin College Khalishpur was held Thursday.

Police arrested Sabuj from Ananta cinema hall area in Pabna on May 16, 1995 for his alleged involvement in the murder of Chhatra League (BCL) and Jatiyatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) contested, while Islamic Chhatra Shibir boycotted the election.

In the election SM Faruque Ahmed and Jahidur Rahman Tushar of BCL (Zaman) faction have been elected VP and GS respectively. Syed Abdullah AL-Mahmud and Syed Kamruzzaman of the same faction have been elected pro-VP and AGS respectively. JCD won four seats in the 16-member cabinet of the students' union, while none of BCL (Ashraf) faction has won a single seat.

Later on in a press briefing the candidates of BCL (Ashraf) faction demanded re-election and removal of OC Khalishpur.
