



KHULNA, Jan 14: A five-day

PDB holds pre-bid meet

Bangladesh Power Develop-ment Board (PDB) held a pre-bid meeting yesterday with a host of international companies who procured tender documents to compete the installation of a 60 MW gas turbine power plant project at Shahjibazar, reports

Nuruddin M Kamal, chairman of PDB inaugurated the pre-bid meeting in WAPDA auditorium.

The estimated cost of the project is Tk. 142 crore of which the foreign exchange component is Tk. 110 crore. The government of Bangladesh will finance the project.

Representatives of 38 companies from 16 countries took part in the pre-bid meeting for discussion with the officials and experts of PDB.

Tender for the gas turbine plant was floated in November last. While the last date of submission of the tender is February 16. The plant is likely to start generation power by the year 2000.

The prospective bidders who have procured tender documents are from Bangladesh. Japan, Malaysia, Korea, China, Singapore, India, the UAE, the USA, Germany, England, Scot-land, Holland, Italy, Poland and Spain.

Attack on cable TV office: One held By Staff Correspondent

One person was arrested in connection with the attack on a control room of a cable television network at Dhanmondi in the city on Monday.

The respect, identified as Wahid Jamil, 30, of Jafrabad area, was arrested Monday night. He was produced before the Chief Metropolitan Magistrate's court and later sent to jail, police said.

The control room at the office of Comtech Cable Network on Road no. 7A, Dhanmondi, was gutted when an armed gang allegedly hurled a petrol bomb inside its premises at about 2:30 pm Monday, according to re-

Stern action against outlawed parties directed

The government today di-rected the law-enforcers to go for stern action to stop underground political activities of some outlawed parties in the country's southeastern region. reports UNB.

An official announcement said the directive came from the third meeting of the Cabinet Committee on Law and Order. held in the Cabinet room with Home Minister Rafiqul Islam in the chair.

The meeting hoped that those who are engaged in "ter-rorist activities in the name of politics" would come back to normal life rectifying themselves in the country's changed

political atmosphere. Education Minister AHSK Sadique, Commerce and Indus-tries Minister Tofael Ahmed. Energy and Mineral Resources Minister Nooruddin Khan, Agriculture, Food and Relief Minister Begum Matia Chowd-hury and Minister for Law, Justice and Parliamentary Affairs Abdul Matin Khasru attended the meeting.

Secretary to the Prime Minister, Home Secretary, Law and Justice Secretary, Inspector General of Police and senior officials of Home Ministry were also present.

The meeting elaborately reviewed the overall law-and-order situation and instructed the authorities concerned to ensure desired improvement in law and order by curbing terrorism.

It also emphasised the need for gearing up the activities of the concerned forces in checking illegal trafficking of drugs and its use, and smuggling in the frontier.

DCCI team meets Kibria

Dhaka Chamber of Commerce and Industry (DCCI) yesterday hailed the government decision to make industrial investment tax-free and not to question the source of the private investment, reports UNB.

WP suggests inclusion of China, Myanmar


