Quader, Chinese leader discuss cooperation in cultural affairs

State Minister for Youth and Sports Cultural Affairs Obaidul Quader, now on a ten-day visit in China yesterday called on vice chairman of the National Peoples' Congress of China Wang Guaying, at the great Hall of the People in Beijing, according to a message received here, reports BSS.

They discussed matters relating to mutual cooperation in developing youth, sports and cultural affairs.

The vice chairman stressed on the need for more and regular exchanges of cultural delegations.

Bangladesh cultural delegation visited the National Art Gallery and Central Drama Academy of China. They also attended a banquet hosted by vice chairman of the All China Youths Federation, Yuan Chungging.

Other members of Bangladesh delegation are: noted litterateur Syed Shamsul Haq, cultural personality Syed Hasan Imam, artist Hashem Khan and joint-secretary of the Ministry of Cultural Affairs Zia-ul-Islam Chowdhury. Bangladesh Ambassador to China Mustafizur Rahman were present during the meeting.

BUETTA president talks to BSS Govt urged to formulate democratic university ordinance

The newly elected president of the Bangladesh University of Engineering and Technology (BUETTA) Dr. Aminul Hoque underlined the need for collective effort to maintain a congenial academic atmosphere on the campus, reports BSS.

He urged the government to formulate a democratic university ordinance like the University Act 1973 for ensuring transparency and accountability within the university family.

Though terrorism is not a vital issue for BUET campus at present, it may penetrate from outside, he said, adding, the sources of terrorism is to be uprooted for ensuring a violence free campus.

In an interview with BSS yesterday Dr Hoque expressed his satisfaction at different measures taken by the government for resolving the crisis prevailing in the education sector and other national issues.

Welcoming the recent addresses of President Justice Shahabuddin Ahmed, delivered at the convocation ceremonies of Jahangirnagar University and North South University, Dr Hoque suggested to delink the student's organisations from their respective political parties.

He highly appreciated different speeches of Prime Minister Sheikh Hasina where she urged students to hold books and pens instead of firearms. All political parties should support the constructive steps of the present government for political stability and national development as well, he said.

Dr Hoque urged the government to refix the warrant of precedence of the university teachers which will not be below that of the judges of the Supreme Court and secretaries.

Credit disbursed among slum-dwellers in Ctg

CHITTAGONG, Jan 14: The Minister of State for Labour and Manpower, M.A. Mannan today called upon non-government voluntary organisations to supplement the government's efforts for the development of slum-dwellers, reports BSS.

Distributing credits and certificates among slum-dwellers at a function organised by the Social Welfare Directorate, the state minister said one-third of the people living in Chittagong metropolitan are slum-dwellers. Without improvement of the socio-economic condition of the slum-dwellers, coveted development of the city would remain a far cry, he added.

City Mayor Mohiuddin Ahmed Chowdhury and officials of the Social Welfare Directorate also spoke on the occasion.

The Social Welfare Directorate, under its Urban Development Programme, has so far disbursed credit amounting to Taka 5,86,000 among 406 families in nine slum areas under Kotwali thana. The distressed women in these slums also created a fund of Taka 35,000.

Today, some 36 families received credits amounting to Taka one lakh and eight thousand.

Besides extending credits, the Social Welfare Directorate has been conducting other services like imparting training on different trades and handicraft. It is also running a 50-bed hostel for working women.

Mannan reiterated the government's commitment to uplift the city and said distressed and neglected section in the society would get priority. The government is taking all steps to provide due facilities to the children in the slum areas, he added.

Art exhibition opens in Khulna

KHULNA, Jan 14: A five-day contemporary art exhibition began here yesterday at the Zia Hall marking the 120th birth anniversary of artist Shashi Bhusan Paul, reports BSS.

Shashi Bhusan Paul was born in Moheswar Pasha village under Daulatpur thana of Khulna district in 1877. He was awarded about 40 international gold medals for his outstanding art works. Under his personal initiative, the Moheswar Pasha School of Art was established in 1904, which was the first of its kind in Bangladesh. The art school has now been turned into Khulna Art college.

The exhibition was formally inaugurated by Khulna City Corporation Mayor Shaikh Tayebur Rahman.

Presided over by acting principal of Khulna Art College, Baby Aulona, the inaugural function was addressed, among others, by Khulna Museum keeper Anwarul Haq, former principal and secretary of Moheswar Pasha School of Art, Sk Alauddin and Mina Musur respectively, vice-president of Group of Theatre, Shahin Jamal and lecturer of Khulna art college, Md Nazrul Islam.

Works by eight artists, including Alauddin Ahmed, Md Nazrul Islam Agrabani, Md Abul Ahsan Rokon, Sharif Mohammad Mostafizur Badsha, Suranjit Mihir, Biplob Bipradas and Goutom Biswas are being exhibited here.

PDB holds pre-bid meet

Bangladesh Power Development Board (PDB) held a pre-bid meeting yesterday with a host of international companies who procured tender documents to compete the installation of a 60 MW gas turbine power plant project at Shahjibazar, reports BSS.

Nuruddin M Kamal, chairman of PDB inaugurated the pre-bid meeting in WAPDA auditorium.

The estimated cost of the project is Tk. 142 crore of which the foreign exchange component is Tk. 110 crore. The government of Bangladesh will finance the project.

Representatives of 38 companies from 16 countries took part in the pre-bid meeting for discussion with the officials and experts of PDB.

Tender for the gas turbine plant was floated in November last. While the last date of submission of the tender is February 16, the plant is likely to start generation power by the year 2000.

The prospective bidders who have procured tender documents are from Bangladesh, Japan, Malaysia, Korea, China, Singapore, India, the UAE, the USA, Germany, England, Scotland, Holland, Italy, Poland and Spain.

LDF holds rally

Leaders of eight-party Left Democratic Front Monday urged the authorities to take action against the persons responsible for the attack on the workers of National Foundry at Shyampur, payment of their arrears wages, withdrawal of cases against union leaders.

The demands were made at a rally held in front of the Jatiya Press Club presided over by A F Mabbubul Huq, coordinator of the LDF.

The LDF leaders alleged that hired hands of the owner attacked the workers to force them out of the factory leaving one worker, Giasuddin's tendons cut. They accused the owner of violating an agreement with the union. They also criticised police for not taking action against the attackers.

Attack on cable TV office : One held

One person was arrested in connection with the attack on a control room of a cable television network at Dhanmondi in the city on Monday.

The respect, identified as Wahid Jamil, 30, of Jafarabad area, was arrested Monday night. He was produced before the Chief Metropolitan Magistrate's court and later sent to jail, police said.

The control room at the office of Comtech Cable Network on Road no. 7A, Dhanmondi, was gutted when an armed gang allegedly hurled a petrol bomb inside its premises at about 2:30 pm Monday, according to reports.

Stern action against outlawed parties directed

The government today directed the law-enforcers to go for stern action to stop underground political activities of some outlawed parties in the country's southeastern region, reports UNB.

An official announcement said the directive came from the third meeting of the Cabinet Committee on Law and Order, held in the Cabinet room with Home Minister Rafiqul Islam in the chair.

The meeting hoped that those who are engaged in "terrorist activities in the name of politics" would come back to normal life rectifying themselves in the country's changed political atmosphere.

Education Minister AHSK Sadique, Commerce and Industries Minister Tofael Ahmed, Energy and Mineral Resources Minister, Nouruddin Khan, Agriculture, Food and Relief Minister Begum Matia Chowdhury and Minister for Law, Justice and Parliamentary Affairs Abdul Matin Khasru attended the meeting.

Secretary to the Prime Minister, Home Secretary, Law and Justice Secretary, Inspector General of Police and senior officials of Home Ministry were also present.

The meeting elaborately reviewed the overall law-and-order situation and instructed the authorities concerned to ensure desired improvement in law and order by curbing terrorism.

It also emphasised the need for gearing up the activities of the concerned forces in checking illegal trafficking of drugs and its use, and smuggling in the frontier.

DCCI team meets Kibria

Dhaka Chamber of Commerce and Industry (DCCI) yesterday hailed the government decision to make industrial investment tax-free and not to question the source of the private investment, reports UNB.

This was communicated to Finance Minister Shah AMS Kibria when the newly-elected executive committee of DCCI, led by its president ASM Quasem, called on the minister at his office in the city.

The chamber leaders hoped that investment in the country's industrial sector would be increased as a result of the government decision, which was endorsed by the Cabinet Monday.

The DCCI delegation apprised the minister about various problems of the business community, including delay in duty realisation, and necessity of improving infrastructure and development in the capital market.

Kibria gave the delegation members a patient hearing and assured them of effective measures to resolve the problems.

He said the government would continue to provide support and assistance to the business community for the country's economic development.

DCCI vice-presidents Ashraf Ibne Noor and Manzur-Hossain and other committee executives were present during the meeting.

Sub-regional grouping WP suggests inclusion of China, Myanmar

Workers Party made an alternative suggestion for bringing Myanmar and China into the fold of proposed sub-regional grouping comprising India, Nepal, Bhutan and Bangladesh, for optimum utilisation of resources of the region, reports UNB.

The proposal came from a two-day meeting of the WP politburo, held in the city with party president Amal Sen in the chair yesterday.

Besides preserving interest of Bangladesh, such forum will make Bangladesh a partner in exploration and extraction of mineral resources, use of water, electricity and forest resources," the meeting observed.

The Workers Party termed the decision on sub-regional grouping comprising India, Bangladesh, Nepal and Bhutan as "ill-conceived", saying "this step will create doubt and distrust in the question of regional cooperation in this region."

It called for a national debate on the question of sub-regional grouping before taking any step in this regard.

The meeting was attended by party general secretary Rashed Khan Menon, Politburo member Haider Akbar Khan Rono, Bimal Biswas and Saiful Haque, said a press release.

Fire at jute mills in Tangail

TANGAIL, Jan 14: Jute goods and some machinery were gutted in a fire in the Islam Jute Mills at Goral under Mirzapur thana this morning.

Fire service sources said the fire originated from an electric short circuit at around 9 am.

Immediately after the fire broke out the Tangail fire service was informed of the mishaps but they could not undertake any operation as their water pumping device was out of order.

The Gazipur fire brigade personally rushed to the spot and extinguished the blaze after four hours.
