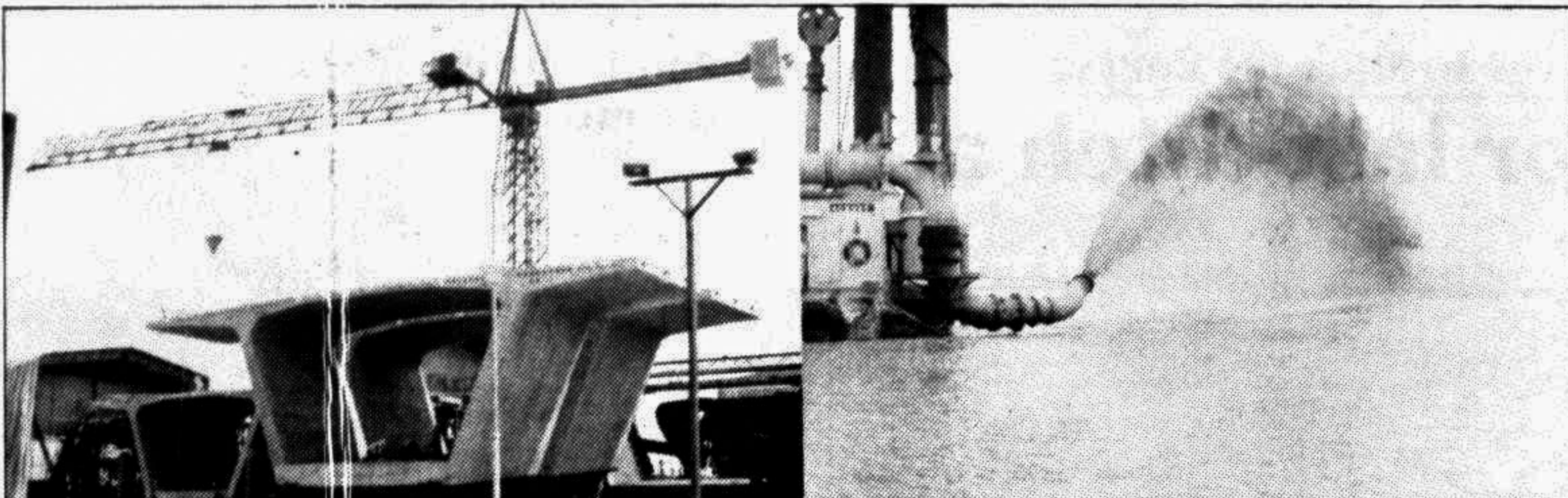

Tk 12cr project to protect bordering territory from river erosion

SYLHET, Jan 15: The Water Development Board has taken up a number of schemes to protect the Bangladesh territory from the large-scale erosion on the banks of the rivers Surma and Kushiyara in Jakiganj thana in Sylhet region. The 12 crore 77 lakh taka project has been taken up under the Border Protection programme, disclosed a concerned official on condition of anonymity.

The schemes include, protection works on the banks of Surma and Kushiyara at different points in Jakiganj thana where the rivers are marking the international borders with India. The scheme, to protect the Surma riverside territory at Amolshid would cost Tk. 2 crore 50 lakh while the scheme

at Bhuiyarmona where the bank of Kushiyara will be protected, would cost about 4 crore 94 lakh taka, the source said.

Under the same programme of protection of territory, the scheme at Gangajal, taken up to protect from the erosion in the river Kushiyara, would cost Taka one crore while the scheme at Ujirpur would cost Taka one crore 11 lakh and protection of the lands attached to the Shrine of Shah Sharif in the same thana will cost Taka one crore 25 lakh, the source informed.

An additional amount of Taka one and a half crore would be spent for execution of the lands near the thana headquarters of Jakiganj under the

ADP. The government would fund these schemes from its own resource, the source said.

An amount of Taka 47 lakh would be spent for execution of a riverbank protection works near Jakiganj under the same programme. The World Bank would provide financial assistance for this scheme, the source added.

Meanwhile, a number of local organisations, including the Jakiganj Krishak Sangram Parishad have demanded for immediate start of the works on the schemes with a view to saving the territory from the clutches of serious erosion, which cause huge loss to both lands and other property almost every year. They alleged that, due to unusual delay even

in the normal maintenance works by the Water Development Board at Jakiganj, the projects give no benefit. They alleged that, a section of employees in connivance with some contractors grab most of the sanctioned money almost every year.

When contacted, some officials of the Water Development Board (WDB) said, measures had been taken to start the works at Bhuiyarmona and Amolshid soon.

They said the contractors had been engaged and work orders issued. They also stated that, the government had given maximum emphasis for protection of the country's territory from erosion and ensured necessary funds for the project.

Abduction of Runa FF held for his alleged involvement

SYLHET, Jan 15: The Commander of Sylhet sadar thana unit of Mukti Joddha Sangstha has been arrested by the police Monday on charge of his alleged involvement in kidnapping a daughter of an elderly Mukti Joddha. The police is also vigorously searching to arrest a senior leader of the Sylhet District unit of the Sangstha in the same case, official sources said.

Enamul Haque Chowdhury Birpratik who is also an ex-MP is one of the accused in the case in which the total number of accused is 15, the source added.

Kala Miah, a freedom fighter lodged a case with the police stating that, the accused persons swooped on a rickshaw which was carrying Kala Miah and his daughter Runa Laila, 20, in the night following January 9 when they were passing the Chowhatta area of the town. The attackers kidnapped Runa, and tortured her one after another. She, however, managed to escape in the midnight next day (January 10).

A case was lodged with the Kotwali police that night and the victim was admitted in to the Sylhet MAG Osmani Memorial College Hospital. She is under treatment there, till writing of the report.

Kailashtila Gas Field Stalemate continues for 7th day

SYLHET, Jan 15: Works in the Kailashtila gas field remained suspended for the seventh day Tuesday due to the blockade put by the agitators.

Four loaded tank lorries which tried to go out of the complex were prevented by the agitators. The Managing Director of Sylhet Gas Fields Ltd, riding on a vehicle tried to enter into the complex but was resisted by the agitators at about 11-30. However, there was no report of any untoward incident.

The All-party Action Committee put the programme to press their 6-point demands. The demands include, Setting up of Fractionation and LPG plants at Kailashtila. Cancellation of acquisition of private lands in the name of Jalalabad Gas. Jobs for the local people in the Petrobangla establishments. Setting up of a Gas Turbine power plant at Golapganj.

In the afternoon, a big public meeting was held at Golapganj Bus Terminal with thana BNP secretary and action committee leader Mohius Sunnah Chowdhury Narjis in the chair.

It was also, addressed by, the Thana Jatiya Party president Osman Harun Chowdhury, Thana Ameer and Secretary of Jamaat-e-Islami Syed Nasiruddin Hafiz Najmul Islam, leaders of Khelafat Majlis and others.

The speakers called upon the government to immediately take necessary measures to meet their genuine demands.

GOPALGANJ, Jan 15: A candidate of Secondary School Certificate (SSC) examination has allegedly committed suicide by hanging with the ceiling of the roof in his father's house.

The victim, Partha Biswas, 16, allegedly committed suicide at midnight on January 10.

It was learnt, Partha Biswas, son of Khokon Biswas, of village Ragunathpur under Gopalganj Sadar thana committed suicide by hanging with the ceiling of the roof in his father's house. It was learnt from the local people, Partha Biswas committed suicide following his failure in love.

A case of Unnatural Death (UD) was filed with the Gopalganj Police Station in this connection.

The deadbody was sent to the Gopalganj morgue for autopsy.

Arms, ammunition recovered: Alleged absconder held

GAIBANDHA, Jan 15: Gobindaganj thana police arrested an absconder accused who is allegedly a gang leader of criminals. Solaiman Ali and recovered one revolver and nine rounds of ammunition from his possession in a raid on January 13.

Receiving a secret information, a police contingent of Gobindaganj thana led by Sub-Inspector (SI) Ashraf Ali raided the house of Khaibar Ali of village Khangsha under Gobindaganj thana and arrested alleged notorious Solaiman. According to his confessional statement police also recovered one revolver along with nine rounds of ammunition from his possession. Police said the accused was an absconder who was underground for a long period and who was involved in several cases. He was an alleged terror of the locality. The arrested person was taken to police custody.
