Former minister Aminul Islam dead

Air Vice-Marshal (retd) KM Aminul Islam, a former minister, died of a heart attack on Saturday in Los Angeles, USA, a Jatiya Party press release said yesterday. He was 64.

Born at Medini Mondal Village under Lohajang thana in 1933, Aminul Islam joined the Pakistan Air Force and was commissioned in 1952. He served in different high posts during his service period.

Aminul Islam also served as ministers for labour, manpower, irrigation, water resources and flood control, jute and textile, religious affairs, local government and works as a member of Cabinet of the Bangladesh government.

Former president and chairman of Jatiya Party Hussain Muhammad Ershad and acting chairman of Jatiya Party Mizanur Rahman Chowdhury expressed their deep shock at the death of Aminul Islam.

He was on his way to Jessore by bus when he was taken ill on Jan 9. Later, he was taken to Khulna General Hospital where he died the following day.

Mokshed was buried at his family graveyard at Pancharahi village under Keshabpur thana in Jessore district. He has left behind his wife, three sons and two daughters.
