Bloody clash over possession of *khas* land at Chatmohar

PABNA, Jan 20: Tension has gripped again in and around 500 acres *khas* land of *Beel Kurulia* under Chatmohar thana, as the land lords and a section of influential persons of the area, have allegedly attacked the landless peasants who are in possession of the aforesaid land. They were cultivating the land and harvesting crops since long.

The attack was made within the knowledge of Chatmohar thana police on Friday and at least 30 persons of both sides were injured including seven women — all being landless peasants. Twenty of the injured persons were admitted to Chatmohar Thana Hospital and Pabna General Hospital.

The injured landless peasants are: Wahab, 35, Anwar, 36, Alim, 31, Matijan, 55, Halima Khatun, 60, Hajera Khatun, 35, Amur Ara, 65, Bhanujan, 28, Jaigan Bibi, 32, Moharjan, 55, Hafizul, 14, Saidul 10, Abu Shama, 45 and Afaz, 60.

The land lords and influential people engaged musclemen to teach a lesson to the landless peasants.

Several persons, namely, Abul Hossain, 40, Sahrawardy, 30, Maqbul, 30, Saban 25, Abul Hossain, 55, and Abdur Razzak, 60, received injuries in the clash and were hospitalised.

The landlords claim, they have got "*Kabulyats*" in their favour and hence they have got legal rights over a portion of the land. The landless peasants alleged that those "*Kabulyats*" were all false, fabricated and of no legal validity and also that cases were pending for cancellation of those illegal *Kabulyats*. They also claimed that unless the matter was resolved through disposal of cases pending against them, they were trying to illegally and forcibly pressurising the landless peasants. They also said that only landless peasants have got legal right to get permanent settlement of the above *khas* land of the government and the illegal claimants cannot get the same as they were not landless peasants.

Ataur Rahman Rana, a popular peasant leader and Executive Director of Landless Peasants Development Organisation (LD0) of Chatmohar thana, long before the bloody occurrence of clash on Friday, but unfortunately police did not take any preventive measure. For this reason, the landlords and fake document holders got the courage to attack the landless peasants.

Cases and counter-cases have been lodged with the thana, the peasant leader told. Meanwhile, in spite of such armed attack, the landless peasants have not given up the possession of the concerned land. Rather, the peasants — both men and women were guarding the land. Women peasants have taken a bold stand in a very organised manner, in guarding the land.

The police, when contacted said that the incident was unfortunate and they were investigating as to which side was actually responsible for the occurrence of clash. They asserted that no more any such incident would take place as police was sufficiently active and alert.

Meanwhile, it needs to mention here that the problem of *khas* land of *Beel Kurulia* is a very long standing one. Dispute over the land — 500 acres in area — of the said

Beel, has been continuing since 36 years. During this period, so many clashes took place, two landless peasants, namely Wadud and Kashem were murdered and as many as 200 persons from both sides were injured. Besides, nearly 20 cases, civil, criminal and settlement cases and appeals were pending before different courts.

The landless peasants came into possession of this *khas* land — actual area being 468.19 acres — and since then they were cultivating the same and harvesting crops. Since the period, they submitted applications to the appropriate authorities in the Revenue Department for giving permanent settlement of the said land in their favour. On the spot inquires and investigation were made on so many occasion by the Assistant Commissioners of land, Thana Nirbahi Officers, the Additional Deputy Commissioner (Revenue), Deputy Commissioners and ultimately, in 1995, by the Secretary Ministry of Land. The present Secretary of Land has also met with the leaders of the landless peasants some three months back and assured them that since the existing laws of the land were in favour of the landless peasants, so the matter would be resolved in their favour.

All the records have been called for the appropriate authorities in Dhaka and it was being expected that the problems and sufferings of the landless peasants would soon come to an end. The landless peasants said that according to all indication, either before the Holy Eid-ul-Fitr or soon after the festival, hearing on the dispute would start in Dhaka and, receiving such an indication, the so-called *Kabulyat* holders became impatient and also very much suspicious about the results of the said hearing. Hence, it is alleged, they were taking every possible measures to take the land into their possession for establishing the genuineness of their claim of having possession.

Besides, a section of local influential, in collusion with a section of dishonest officials, got their names recorded during the Revisional Settlement Operation. An area of 267.37 acres of government *khas* land were thus wrongly recorded in the name of several persons who claimed the land either on the basis of false papers, deeds, documents and decrees fraudulently obtained or prepared by the interested circles. But when the matter was brought to notice of the higher authorities in Dhaka, the authorities intervened and by an order, has stopped the final printing and publication of the so-called R.S. (Revisional Settlement) *khatians*.

The chairman of the Land Appeal Board has called for all the records and also has started hearings of each case separately.

The landless peasants leader Ataur Rahman Rana while talking to The Daily Star on Saturday said that the police should refrain the other side from their efforts to pressurise the landless peasants and the District Administration should actively take steps for punishing the "*lalchals*" and "*fake Kabulyatwallas*" as they were creating law and order situation and harassing the poor peasants by filing a number of false cases against the poor and helpless people.

The peasant leaders further said that they have already sent representations to the Prime Minister and Minister in-charge of Land praying for a quick solution of the problem strictly adhering to the provisions of law.

517 certificate cases filed against farmers

SATKHIRA, Jan 20: A total of 517 certificate cases have been filed against loan defaulters in Tala thana of Satkhira district last year.

The defaulters took agricultural loans from the local branches of Bangladesh Krishi Bank, Sonali Bank and Janata Bank under the thana during the period of 1988-1990. Out of the disbursed loan, a total of Taka 43, 92, 977 have been remained unrepaid.

One convicted for misappropriating wheat

KISHOREGANJ, Jan 20: Md Shahidullah, Special and Additional Session Judge, Kishoreganj in a judgement delivered on January 13 convicted an UP member and sentenced him to suffer rigorous imprisonment for four years and to pay a fine of Taka 10,000 or in default to suffer RI for another four months on charge of misappropriation of wheat meant for a project under food for works programme.

According to the prosecution, during the financial year 1989-90, in total 46 point 225 metric tons of wheat were sanctioned for the reconstruction of the road running from Natun bazar to Magura beel in Kishoreganj sadar thana and a project committee was formed with Md Nur Rahman, a member of Karshakari union parishad as its chairman.

The project chairman lifted 23 metric tons of wheat in two installments and misappropriated 9 point 41 metric tons. The prices of the misappropriated wheat was fixed at Taka 55.465.

The matter was later brought to the notice of the district Anti-Corruption Bureau. The Bureau lodged a case and after proper investigation submitted charge-sheet against the project chairman.

Bangladesh Krishi Bank filed 12 cases against outstanding loan of Taka 1596052. Sonali Bank filed 124 cases against outstanding loan amounting to Taka 2991175 and Janata Bank filed 172 cases against outstanding loan of Taka 1805750.

However, the farmers said that though they received the loan amount as per record, in reality they received only 75 per cent of the loan amount. The remaining 25 per cent of the amount had to be shared with the bank employees and office-bearers of the local union parishad as per gratification.

Some defaulter farmers said, they had repaid the original loan amount and had applied to waive the interest, but the bank authorities calculated compound interest and have now filed certificate cases.

Nine inter-city dacoits held

JAMALPUR, Jan 20: Police rounded up nine inter-city dacoits and recovered looted goods from their possession on Wednesday, reports UNB.

Police said a gang of dacoits looted 28 drums full of diesel from a petrol pump owned by one Belal Uddin at Dipait Bus stand bazar in Sadar thana on Dhaka-Jamalpur highway on Jan 11.

Later, police recovered the looted goods and arrested the dacoits from Dholaipar in Demra thana, Dhaka, following a case filed with Jamalpur Sadar thana.

Absconding convict held

SAVAR, Jan 20: A convicted absconding man was arrested by police on Friday from a market here, reports UNB.

Police said Anwar, Miah convicted for five years in a toll extortion case was arrested from Nabinagar cantonment market. He was tried in absentia some months back.

500 met unnatural death in Sylhet in '96

SYLHET, Jan 20: About 500 people met unnatural deaths in four districts of Sylhet division last year.

Official source said that, the total number include 148 who were killed in road accidents, while 64 committed suicide, 111 were murdered, while 175 others died due to different other unnatural reasons.

Of the total deaths, 6 were murdered, two committed suicide and 19 were killed in road accidents and 13 others met their end of life due to some other reasons during the month of January. The total number of deaths stood at 40, during the month.

During the month of February, the number total unnatural deaths in the division stood at 39. It include, 19 murders, 8 suicides, while road accidents related deaths 10 and 6 others died due to some other reasons.

During the month of March the number of unnatural deaths stood at 35. Those include 13 murders, while 3 committed suicide and road accidents related deaths were 12 and 7 others died due to some other reasons in the division.

In the month of April, 37

unnatural deaths were reported in the division. The figures include 6 murders, 3 suicides, while road accidents related death were 12 people and 16 others died due to other reasons.

Nine persons were murdered during the month of May, while 6 committed suicide, 8 other were killed in road accidents and 21 died of some other reasons. The total deaths stood at 44 in the month.

Twenty-three persons were the victims of unnatural deaths in the division during the month of June. The numbers include, nine murders, 4 suicides and road accident related 4 lives, while 6 others met the end of their lives due to some other reasons.

In the month of July, 9 persons were killed and 7 committed suicide while road accidents related deaths were 7 and other reasons caused the loss of 23 lives. The total number stood at 44, during the month.

The figure stood at 36 during the month of August, when 12 persons were killed and 3 committed suicide. Road accidents took 8 lives while some

other reasons caused the death of 13 lives.

As many as 46 persons were the victims of unnatural deaths in the division, during the month of September last year. Those include 8 murders and 3 committed suicide, road accidents related deaths were 13, while 22 others met unnatural deaths.

The highest number of unnatural deaths were reported in the division during the month of October when as many as 64 people met their tragic end of life. The death include 12 murders, while 8 committed suicide, and road accidents related deaths were 23 while 21 deaths due to other reasons.

The number of unnatural deaths stood at 50 during the month of November. Twelve persons were murdered and 9 committed suicide, while the road accidents related deaths were 14. Besides, 15 others died due to some other reasons.

In the month of December the number of unnatural deaths stood at 39. Those include 8 murders, 8 suicides and road accident related deaths were 18, while rest 5 deaths were caused by some other reasons.
