
Severe cold wave forecast

A severe cold wave is likely to sweep over Rajshahi and Sylhet divisions and the regions of Mymensingh and Khulna during the next 12 hours, reports UNB.

The Met office said mild cold wave may sweep over Barisal division and Khulna, Jessore, Dhaka, and Comilla regions during the period.

Weather may remain mainly dry with partly cloudy sky over the country during the period but night temperature may fall by 2 to 3 degrees Celsius.

The country's lowest temperature 9.3 degree Celsius, was recorded at Satkhira and the highest, 25.5 degrees, at Madaripur.

Razzak Ali says
Speaker has no
authority to
form committee

Former Speaker Sheikh Razzak Ali Monday questioned the authority of his successor, Humayun Rashid Chowdhury, to form a committee headed by Kader Siddiqui for looking into the security of MPs and the Parliament house, reports UNB.

The six-member parliamentary committee is scheduled to submit its report within three months suggesting security measures for MPs, Sangsads, Bhaban and MP hostels.

Rising on a point of order, Razzak Ali said the Speaker has no authority to constitute a parliamentary committee whatsoever under the Rules of Procedure. It is the House which has got sole authority to form any committee.

"This is unprecedented. This cannot be done," Ali said, adding that the Speaker is the custodian of the House and he has to ensure security and protest privileges of the members.

He argued that the Speaker cannot delegate his power to any individual. He demanded ruling from Deputy Speaker Abdul Hamid on this point.

The Deputy Speaker said he was not aware of such committee and would let the House know about it later.

Lone water pump of DMCH out of order

The lone water pump of the Dhaka Medical College Hospital (DMCH) went out of order Monday, leaving hundreds of patients of the hospital on the mercy of WASA's special supply, reports UNB.

As the water supply from the pump stopped at about 7 am, a large number of attendants and even some patients were seen to crowd on the ground floor of the hospital in search of water.

DMCH authorities, however, managed to supply a few quantity of water under special arrangement with the Dhaka WASA which was to inadequate to meet the demand of the patients.

The hospital authorities were learnt to have slowed down the surgical activities due to the scarcity of water.

The water pump could not be repaired till filing the report at 9:30 pm despite frantic efforts by the authorities.

Bangabandhu killing

Speedy trial of killers demanded

Three renowned writers of the country Monday called for speedy trial of those responsible for the killing of Bangabandhu Sheikh Mujib Rahman, his family members and others on August 15, reports BSS.

In a joint statement, poet Begum Sufia Kamal, novelist Shawkat Osman and poet Shamsur Rahman said it was not supportable from the viewpoints of existing law, social justice, political ideals, international human rights and, above all, religion to acquit any killer without a proper trial.
