# Players' protest

From Tawfiq Aziz Khan MELBOURNE, Jan 23: Top tennis stars playing at the Ford Australian Open Wednesday signed a protest letter over the decision to close the roof at Melbourne Park Centre Court this week. Referee Peter Bellenger told a press conference that he had taken the decision to close the roof for Tuesday's quarterfinal match between Carlos Moya and Mantilla. played in 40-degree temperature. Signatories to the letter include, among others, Pete Sampras. Thomas Muster, Goran Ivanisevic, Carlos Moya and Felix Mantilla. The players also resented the lack of communication and the short time they were given to adjust to indoor playing conditions. The players were united in their condemnation of the move the fist time the roof had been closed because of heat in the Australian Open's 10 years history at the Tennis Centre, reports the Herald Sun. Ivanisevic, forced by rain to play with the roof shut Wednesday said his match should have been postponed as he disapproved of any indoor play at a Grand Slam Championship Thomas Muster who defeated Ivanisevic categorically said in his interview that it did not matter because he was a professional and should play under any conditions. Ivanisevic said that there should not be any Grand Slam matches indoors because what would happen if they did not have a roof. Meanwhile the Australian Medical Association rallied in support of the decision to close the roof. The AMA Victorian Vice President Dr. Anthony Dixon said he was worried by the attitude of the people who dismissed the danger posed by high temperatures and insisted the Open should continue outdoors regardless of the heat. But Dr. Dixon did not comment on players continuing in the excessive heat on the outdoor courts. The general policy guidelines for opening and closing of the retractable roof clearly stipulates. # Hingis, Pierce in final

MELBOURNE. Jan 23 The teen age Swiss sensation Martina Hingis has set up a dream final against French beauty Mary Pierce here on

Saturday. Both ladies won their matches in style against Mary Joe Fernandez and Amanda

Coetzer respectively. Pierce, who was the 1995 champion here was the first to reach the final for the second time in her career brushing aside, what could be a serious challenge from the giant-killer Amanda Coetzer of South Africa. A semifinalist last year also Amanda's dream for a final berth dashed to the ground as her younger opponent broke through her service game time and again to finally win 7-5, 6-1. Amanda, seeded 12 who did not drop a set in her five previous match was clearly not in her best of touch and went down in 74 minutes.

It was a day of jubilation for 16-year-old Martina Hingis who is tipped by the pundits to lift the title this year. If that happens she will be the voungest ever to do so since Monica Seles did it in 1991 at the age of 16 years, 6 months. Martina might beat Monica by two months. For a girl of her age Hingis showed tremendous resilience and maturity against Mary Joe-Fernandez, seeded 14 and two-time finalist. Hingis had an easy match compared to Pierce and won comfortably 6-1, 6-3. It was a lackluster semifinal lasting only 69 minutes.

In the three matches that Pierce and Hingis played against each other so far Pierce won all in straight sets. This will be their fourth meet and Hingis hopes to turn the table on Pierce.

AP adds: Hingis, meanwhile, is looking to magic.

Magic Girl was the horse that threw her on Tuesday, and "it was magic for me. She just helped me a lot, made the light go on after that fall. Since then I changed completely.'

Except maybe for a flash of anger that delayed her victory over No 14 seed Fernandez, Hingis said she has made nearly no mistakes since being thrown.

"Today I played almost a perfect match. So I think it's

Victory in that match wouldn't be Hingis' first Grand Slam doubles titles, however. She and Sukova won at Wimbledon last year.

Pierce is the first unseeded women's finalist in the Australian since Chris O'Neil won in 1978. The last unseeded women's finalist in one of the majors was Mima Jausovec of Yugoslavia, who lost to Chris Evert in the 1983 French Open.
