

How does a cellular phone work?


Introduced in the eighties, the hand-held portable cellular telephone is the world's most innovative electronic product ever developed.

Cellular systems are made up of radio coverage areas called cells. When a cellular call is made, the cell site sends the call to a Mobile Telephone Switching Office (MTSO) which switches it to the cellular/T&T number dialled.

Why does one have to pay for an incoming call?

A cellular call engages voice channels at the cell site.

By engaging them, the sender and the receiver stops a second caller from using that particular voice channel. Hence, a rental is charged from the receiver as well as the sender.

Can one make/receive a local, NWD/ISD call from a cellular phone?

One can receive **local**, **NWD** and **ISD** calls on a cellular telephone. However, to make an out going NWD/ISD call the facility will be available only on payment of a security deposit.

What is the range of the City Cell network around Dhaka city?

The six cell sites located around Dhaka city are at Moghbazar, Uttara, Mohakhali (MTSO), Narayanganj, Savar and Old The range of these sites extend upto Gazipur, Baburghat, Chandina, Munshiganj and Manikganj.

(No Svc) indicator will beep automatically.
