## Mad race for admission in Rajshahi schools

RAJSHAHI, Jan 24: Problem of admission for boys and girls in schools has become very critical in Rajshahi. Lesser number of schools in proportion to huge number of students has made the crisis. Almost all the schools of the city have already announced the dates and schedule for admission tests. Guardian are being seen anxiously visiting from one school to another to collect application forms and admit cards and to endeavour whether a sit can be managed somehow.

Rajshahi, an area lagging behind economically, is well-known for its educational institutions. But, in fact, number of educational institutions is not sufficient enough to cope with the situation.

Situation is more pitiable in the primary and secondary lev-

els. To name the good schools, Rajshahi Collegiate School, Government Laboratory High School, PN Girls' High School, Shiroil Government High School and Helenabad Girls' High School can be listed which have both primary and secondary levels.

Among the private institutions, Masjid Mission Academy and Summit School have attracted people's attraction for their well-managed techniques and good results.

According to sources, more than six lakhs people now live in the city corporation area. But there are only 35 high schools in the city. Out of a total of 22 schools are for the boys and the rest 13 for the girls. Only three boys high schools permit co-education where a very few girls get admitted.

Out of the total schools, only six are for boys and two for girls government high schools, which only are considered good and standard. In last twenty years, neither a single government school was established here nor a private school was nationalised. The government did not take any mentionable programmes for development and extension of the existing government schools to meet the increasing demand.

It is learnt that there are about 900 seats in six government schools this year in primary section and upper class eight in secondary section.

Guardians are eager to get their children admitted into these schools there exist required number of teachers, staffs and necessary equipments.

### Strike in protest against attack on R&H engineer

SIRAJGANJ, Jan 24: Officials and employees of the district Roads and Highway Department observed a daylong strike on Thursday protesting the attack on an engineer of the department.

They alleged that Golam Kibria, Executive Engineer of the department, was assaulted by a local contractor after he failed to manage a work permit of the department.

R&H Diploma Engineers' Association and Workers-Employees' Union also held a protest meeting demanding legal action against the offenders.

Later, the protesters submitted a memorandum to the Deputy Commissioner to press their demand.

## Bazar of Kurigram in bad shape

KURIGRAM, Jan 24: Kantbari bazar, one of the biggest business centres of Kurigram district, has long been lacking adequate accommodation, supply of pure drinking water, proper drainage system and dearth of conservancy services.

During the last few years the bazar was not expanded commensurate with the growth of buyers and sellers creating severe stalemate in business transactions.

The roads inside the bazar are not spacious enough to facilitate easy movement of the consumers. Besides, indiscriminate installation of shops has further narrowed the roads which are also in bad shape for want of reconstruction.

The bazar authorities care little to keep the market neat and clean. Although they realise increased taxes from the traders and shopkeepers, heaps of garbage and filth are always dumped in the bazar polluting the atmosphere. There exists no drainage system in the market. As a result, in the rainy season, the bazar goes under water that logs some parts of the market for days together.

The consumers have to take contaminated water from the nearby ponds and canals as the only tubewell there remains out of order for long.

The bazar has no sanitary latrines and urinals. The people respond to the call of nature in the open space much to the annoyance of the people.

There is no dustbin in the bazar and hence garbage piled up on the roads sometimes blocking the movement of pedestrians.

The bazar has not been properly electrified. The major parts of the bazar area plunges into darkness after sundown.

### Fertilizer price up in Satkhira

SATKHIRA, Jan 24: Small and marginal farmers here have been facing acute problem due to high price of fertilizer in the district, reports UNB.

The farmers alleged that the dealers lifting their adequate quota from Khulna release the same in small quantity in the local market here and they sell the rest quantity in the black market to earn windfall profit.

As a result, scarcity of fertilizer has been prevailing in the district, but the affluent farmers can afford to purchase the same from the black market at high prices.

The small and marginal farmers have urged the authority concerned to take action.

### Fertilizer scandal 50I bags seized, godown sealed

NATORE, Jan 24: Police seized 50I bags of fertilizer and sealed a godown of one fertilizer dealer at Gurudaspur thana of the district on January 14.

According to area-dwellers, fertilizer dealer Siddikur Rahman Shah was removing 50I bags of fertilizer, allocated for selling at Gurudaspur thana, from his godown to a godown of another dealer Mujibur Rahman for allegedly selling in black-markets.

Being circulated about the news of the incident around the area, people led by a commissioner of Gurudaspur pourashava, Abdur Rahim, confined the 50I bags of fertilizer and sent message to the TNO.

Later police in presence of Gurudaspur TNO, Hanif Mohammad and the Thana Agriculture Officer, Nasir Uddin Khan, seized the fertilizer bags captured by the people.

The authority also sealed the fertilizer godown of Siddikur Rahman Shah, a government selected fertilizer dealer of Gurudaspur thana.
