The extra forces, official sources said, will be brought and deployed in the city within three to four days as incidents of crime, specially snatching and hijacking, usually increase before the holy festival.

DMP has already reinforced its forces in the city's markets and shopping malls and also at important points which connect lanes and bylanes with the main roads.

We have already brought almost the entire city under control by deploying uniformed and plainclothes police personnel — snatching and toll collection has decreased, DMP Commissioner AK Al Mamun told UNB yesterday.


