Scholarships for students in Bandarban

The Bandarban Hill District Administration has introduced scholarships for meritorious students of Bandarban from this year, reports BSS.

The scholarships will be awarded to meritorious students from secondary to university level. Mohammad Atiqul Islam Chowdhury, Deputy Commissioner of Bandarban said.

Besides, the meritorious students studying in different secondary schools, colleges and madrasas in the district, the permanent residents of the district studying in different colleges, polytechnic institutes, agriculture institutes and universities at any place in the country may apply for the stipend, the DC said.

According to the positions secured in the examinations, held in 1996, stipend at the rate of Tk 5,000 to Tk 3,000 will be awarded to the students of the post-graduation level, Tk 4,000 to Tk 3,000 to graduation level, Tk 4,000 to Tk 2,000 to higher secondary level and Tk 3,000 to Tk 1,000 to students from secondary level, he said. The students in the pre-secondary level securing the first position will also be awarded with an annual stipend of Tk 500 each, he said.

The students have been asked to send their applications, with marksheets and certificates showing the positions secured, to the office of the Deputy Commissioner, Bandarban, as early as possible.

The election was held on Jan 30.



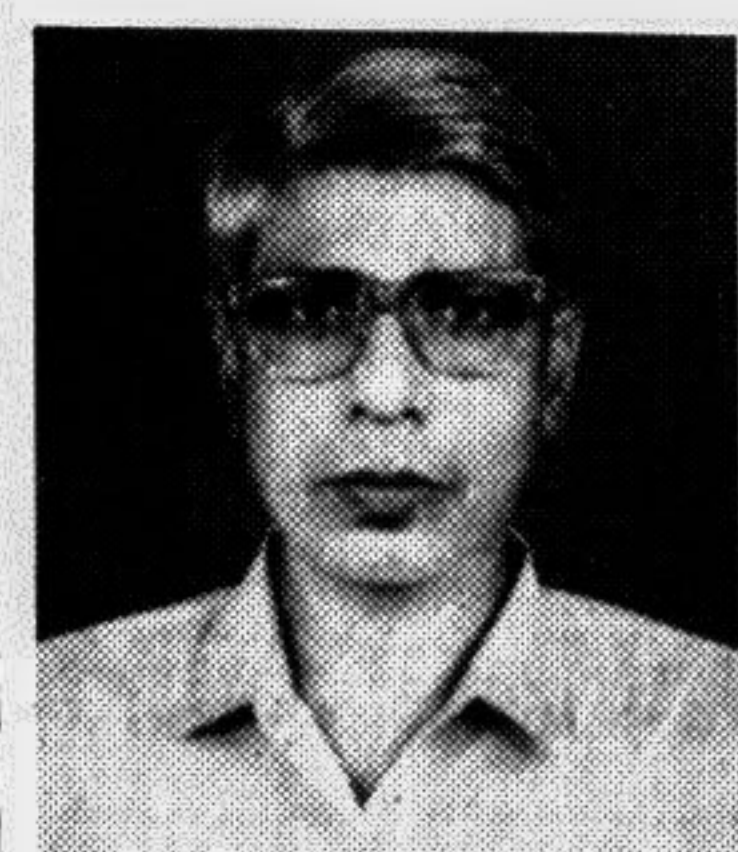
