

Tk 24 cr Chittagong WASA project opens

CHITTAGONG, Feb 14: Chittagong WASA began its second interim water supply rehabilitation project at a cost of Taka 24 crore under its crash programme in order to mitigate the water shortage in the city, reports BSS.

As part of the project a new water pump was installed at Jubilee Road here yesterday.

Chittagong city Mayor Alhaj A B M Mahiuddin Chowdhury inaugurated the project at a simple ceremony. The opening ceremony was presided over by WASA chairman Sultan Mahmood and addressed, among others, by UCBL chairman Jahangir Alam Khan, chief engineer of WASA Mohammad Hossain, ward commissioner M A Malek, and WASA CBA

president Mohammad Nurul Islam.

Mayor in his inaugural speech said city corporation will provide land and other logistic support if WASA undertakes more plans for meeting the increasing demand for water in the city.

The mayor urged the city-dwellers to be more conscious of using water and refrain from wasting water.

With the installation of the water pump, some 24,000 gallons of water would be supplied per hour which would greatly help mitigate the water crisis at Enayetbazar, Batali Road, Goalpara, Newmarket, Court Building, Pathantooli and Dewanhat areas.
