

Bodies of Christian couple exhumed in Sylhet

SYLHET, Feb 16: The bodies of a Christian couple were exhumed from a graveyard Saturday for post-mortem after 4 days of burial.

S M Augustin Chaki, son of the couple on February 13 filed a case with the sadar thana magistrate, alleging that about 25 people armed with deadly weapons including firearms attacked their house on February 9. They threatened Anthony Chaki and his wife Geeta Chaki with dire consequences, he alleged. Geeta Chaki died there immediately and Anthony Chaki got faint. Anthony was immediately admitted into a private hospital where he died next day (February 10).

The deceased, Anthony who had litigation with some people over the ownership of his house at Sheikhghat area in Sylhet filed petition cases with the Divisional Commissioner, DIG of police, SP and others apprehending attack on his life a month ago.

Acute crisis of drinking water in Jamalpur, Sherpur

JAMALPUR, Feb 16: Jamalpur and Sherpur districts have long been facing acute crisis of drinking water due to the failure of the concerned department to ensure minimum supply of water.

Experts believe that water supply in these districts can be augmented by developing new mechanism, but there is no activities in sight for implementation of such programmes.

Twenty per cent of the rural people of these district use tubewell waters for domestic use, while the rest 80 per cent depend on deep tubewell only for drinking water.

In some of the villages in Jamalpur there are no sign of any tubewell. People are compelled to depend on well and derelict ponds for drinking water and other household works. As a result, they become vulnerable to water borne diseases

like diarrhoea and dysentery. Most of the rural people, especially the womenfolk has to travel a long distance to collect drinking water from tubewells.

Statistics show that the ratio of per person tubewell was 1:450 in 1972 which in 1996 stood at 1:150.

The government initiative was negligible in number in comparison with actual demand for it. One fourth of such tubewells remains out of order throughout the year on the one hand, because of fall in the groundwater level. At present drought has further aggravated water crisis in the area.

The tubewells remaining out of order were not re-sunk on emergency basis. Those remain out of order for years together.

The authorities concerned and Department of Public Health Engineering (DPHE) seldom give due and timely attention to the repair or replacement of tubewells.

An engineer of DPHE informed this correspondent that they do repair work of damaged tubewells only at the approval of higher authorities.

Besides, even if repair order comes, due to lack required spare parts the whole process is delayed. The authorities concerned prefer sinking new tubewells rather than repairing the damaged tubewell. For these reasons damaged tubewells remain inoperative for long.

There are two reasons behind less flow of water in the tubewells of this area (i) Fall in the ground water level and (ii) Existence of tubewells in between deep tubewell and shallow tubewells.

Experts suggest that alternative arrangement may be taken up to remove the crisis of water. In almost every village there are deep and shallow tubewells for irrigation purpose which can supply drinking water too to the village people. Tanks can be set up along side the DTW and STW which can be filled two or three times per day. Rural people can easily collect drinking water from those sources. It is believed that once this arrangement is made on experimental basis the village people would start using water from these sources.

One killed, 14 hurt in Sirajganj clash

SIRAJGANJ, Feb 16: An armed clash between two groups of villagers at Kazipur thana here left one man killed and 14 other people injured on Friday, police said, reports UNB.

The dead was identified as Rafiqul Islam, 35, of Gopalpur-Rohabari village. He succumbed to his injuries at Bogra Mohammad Ali Hospital at 5 am Saturday.

The clash occurred as Rafiq prevented his co-villager Aziz from using an irrigation channel running over his cultivable land.

Seriously injured Fazlul Haque and Habibur Rahman were admitted to Kazipur Health Complex.

Father of Rafiq filed a case against 13 people. Police arrested one Khorsheed in this connection.

Coach skids off: 40 passengers injured

CHANDPUR, Feb 16: At least 40 passengers were injured, 10 seriously, when a Dhaka-bound coach from Faridganj via Chandpur town suddenly skidded off the Chandpur-Comilla road at Sholaghar here on Thursday, reports UNB.

According to witnesses, brake failure was the reason behind the accident. Local people rushed to the spot and rescued the trapped passengers inside the bus. Later fire service-men also joined the rescue operation.

Three injured persons were admitted to Chandpur Sadar Hospital. Among them Jalal Uddin (30) of Faridganj was shifted to Dhaka Medical College Hospital in a critical condition. Others were admitted to local private clinics.

Police seized the bus and nabbed the driver.

Two alleged criminals arrested

SATKHIRA, Feb 16: Two youths were rounded up by police for their alleged involvement in various criminal activities in the district, reports UNB.

They were identified as Nazrul, 30, son of Babar Ali of Nalta and Wazir Ali, 27, son of Kadam Ali of Shahpur at Tala thana.

Police-agitators clash

Thousands gherao Sylhet DC office

SYLHET, Feb 16: About two thousand agitators Saturday gheraoed the Deputy Commissioner's office to press home their demand for immediate release of those arrested on Thursday during a police-agitators' clash at Companyganj thana headquarters.

The agitators in procession started from Companyganj thana headquarters held a brief rally in the collectorate premises. They also handed over a memorandum to the Deputy Commissioner. The agitators also demanded action against the police officials responsible for 'attack' on the peaceful procession which was brought out at the thana headquarters to protest holding of obscene dance and gambling in the name Eid fair. About 30 persons were injured in the clash following which police arrested 11 agitators.

Meanwhile, the third day of the hartal passed off Saturday at the Companyganj thana headquarters. All shops remained closed while road communication with the district headquarters also remained snapped.

50 houses burnt within 40 hours!

KHAGRACHHARI, Feb 16: A total of 50 houses, along with four shops were listed officially as burnt at different places of the district during the last 40 hours in three separate fire havocs.

Fire consumed 37 home-steads at Muslimpara in sadar thana of the district at about 9.30 in the morning Thursday. The origin of the fire is yet to be ascertained while the victims thought that it might have been originated from the burning bush which was reportedly meant for taming the severe cold of the members of a hapless family of Muslimpara. Fire Brigade sources from Khagrachhari said.

The second fire which was suspected to be a case of sabotage torched four shops besides the ground floor of the local Power Development Board's office Thursday evening. The shops were allegedly built illegally without the consent of the land owner, local district administration sources said. In

both the cases, local fire brigade controlled the fire.

About 15 dwelling houses were burnt to ashes in the third fire havoc at Nunchhari cluster hamlet in Malschhari union parishad of Mohalchhari thana in the district which was reportedly originated from the oven at midnight on February 13, Thana Nirbahi Officer of Mohalchhari said.

Purushuttam Tripura, a councillor has distributed Friday blanket, saree, lungi, soap and mosquito-nets among the victims of Muslimpara, on behalf of the Khagrachhari Hill District Local Government Council while the Deputy Commissioner of the district Mohammad Ismail disbursed Tk 1,000 to each family, officials said.

The victims of Nunchhari cluster hamlet have been leading inhuman life under the open sky as no relief was given to them till writing his report, sufferers said.

Two killed in road mishaps

KISHOREGANJ, Feb 16: Two persons including a minor boy were killed in two separate road accidents on Kishoreganj-Bhairab road recently.

Police sources said, Al-Amin, 9, son of Moslemuddin of village Jhuluapara in Kishoreganj Sadar thana died on the spot while a Dhaka-bound passenger bus (Dhaka Metro Cha-7298) from Hossainpur ran over him near Puler ghat bridge. The accident occurred while the victim was crossing the road.

In another incident, Shah-jahan, 45, of village Harghat in Tati thana died on the spot at the end of his life while he fell from a speeding bus at Pachalgoti bus stand in Katiadi thana. The victim was travelling on the rooftop of a Bhairab-bound passenger bus (Tangali Ba-275) and suddenly he fell on the ground after he was hit on the head with a branch of a tree. He also died instantly.

Two separate cases were registered with Kishoreganj and Katiadi police stations respectively. Police seized both the buses, but the drivers fled the scenes just after the accidents.

Sarbahara leader held in Barisal

Two Shantibahinimen surrender

NARICHHARI (Khagrachhari), Feb 16: Two armed cadres of the tribal insurgents have given themselves up to security forces frontier camp at Narachhari near Logang in Panchhari thana of the district on February 7 last and laid down arms and ammunitions, according to a delayed official report.
