President opens SAARC conference of NUTS

'Raise modern facilities for treatment of kidney patients'

President Justice Shahabuddin Ahmed yesterday called for taking urgent steps to increase the number of experts and the modern facilities for treatment of kidney patients, reports UNB.

He said the number of post-graduate trainees and specialists should be increased without further delay because of the large number of kidney and urological patients and huge burden of acute chronic kidney failures in the country.

The President was inaugurating the 2nd International Conference of Nephrology, Urology and Transplant Society (NUTS) of SAARC countries at a local hotel in the morning.

About 400 experts from Bangladesh, India, Pakistan, Nepal, Sri Lanka, Singapore, UK, USA and Japan are parti-

cating in the three-day conference.

Health and Family Welfare Minister Salah Uddin Yusuf and State Minister for Health and Family Welfare Prof M Amanullah addressed the inaugural session as special guests.

Health Secretary Muhammed Ali also spoke at the function as guest of honour.

Earlier, Society president Prof SB Das and secretary general Dr Harun-Ur-Rashid delivered speeches at the session.

President Shahabuddin

mentioned that the country has at present only 25 nephrologists, 20 urologists and 45 trainee post graduate students. "It is very insufficient to our needs," he said.

"We cannot shut our eyes to the immediate requirement of our patients, requiring specialised medical treatment," the President added.

He, however, expressed his satisfaction at the rapid development of Nephrology, Urology, Dialysis and transplantation in the country.

The President went on saying that poor patients suffer a lot as they cannot go abroad for treatment spending large sums of money.

"We need modern and sophisticated machines so that the patients can get the required treatment in the country with minimum cost."

He referred to the inadequate medical facilities in the private sector to cope with the growing population.

President Shahabuddin made an ardent appeal to the affluent section of the society to come forward in establishing clinics, medical centres and hospitals, providing medicare facilities to the people at reasonable cost.

Health and Family Welfare Minister Salah Uddin Yusuf said a high powered committee comprising representatives from different strata has been constituted to formulate a comprehensive national health policy.

A law on transplantation of kidney is also being formulated, he said adding that another law will be made to prevent "fake treatment" by quacks.

During her stay in Bangladesh, Job will visit the port city of Chittagong and Sylhet and Moulvibazar towns.

She will meet with mayor Hanif at Nagar Bhaban on Feb 22 and discuss with him matters relating to the cities of Birmingham and Dhaka.

Job is expected to call on Foreign Minister Abdus Samad Azad and LGRD and Cooperatives Minister Zillur Rahman.
