Indian girl rescued

COMILLA, Feb 19: An Indian girl was rescued from a village in Sadar thana here last week, police said, reports UNB.

Mousumi Chandra Tusi, daughter of Sochin Chandra of Arkepur thana of South Tripura district, was abducted from her home district on December 6 last year.

She was brought to Bangladesh through Comilla border by Depol Boumik and Bipro Das. However, details of their identities could not be known.

Comilla police began their search after getting a tip-off from Tripura police. Earlier, Tusi's father filed a case in his country.

On February 8, Sadar police raided the residence of a village doctor at Sreepur in Sadar, recovered Tusi from there, but failed to arrest the abductors.

Meanwhile, local district administration has sent a letter to the district collectorate of Tripura to take back Tusi to her home.

Minor girl killed by miscreants

SATKHIRA, Feb 19: A minor girl of Protapnagar village in Assasun thana was killed by miscreants on the Eid day midnight, reports UNB.

Police said Shilpi, 10, daughter of Shamsur Rahman, was found dead at a fruit garden near her house.

Family sources said they started looking for Shilpi when she was not returning home from a house of the neighbour who called her on the Eid day.

Police, meanwhile, arrested two people — Rokeya and Azizur Rahman — in this connection. The body was sent to morgue for post mortem.

On the same day, a minor boy of Bouchar village in Sadar thana was electrocuted when he came in contact with a live electric wire of a piller at Bokshar road.

Release demanded

Naogaon Chamber of Commerce and Industries (NCCI) has demanded release of one of its member Touhidul Bari who was arrested following the 'unwarranted' incident on the day of holy Eid-ul-Fitr, according to a press release.

NCCI President Md Zahangir Alamgir on Saturday said, Bari was a professional businessman and that he had no connection with the incident. On the Eid day a large number of the *musallis* could not say their prayers at the main *jamaat* in Naogaon due to malfunctioning of sound boxes and other unhappy incidents.

Alam has condemned the arrest of Bari and demanded immediate release of him and other arrested persons.

One killed, 2 hurt in road mishap

KUSHTIA, Feb 19: One person was killed and two others were injured in a road accident on Friday on Bheramara-Raita road, reports BSS.

Eye witnesses said a speeding truck dashed a passenger van and a passenger Azmal, 25, died on the spot. Two other passengers sustained serious injuries. They were admitted to Bheramara Health Complex.

Police seized the truck, but the driver is absconding. A case has been registered in this connection.
