SINGAPORE. Feb 22: A shortage of skilled labour is restricting export growth in major Asian trading nations, senior company executives across the region said in a survey released here Wednesday, reports

"This is especially so in Vietnam, Indonesia, Malaysia, Taiwan and China, where more than six in 10 respondents perceived the problem," said the DHL-Gallup survey, which measures business confidence

A total of 1,125 executives were polled in 15 countries in cluding Australia, Hong Kong, India, Japan, South Korea, New Zealand, the Philippines, Sin-

The poll was commissioned by parcel delivery company DHL Worldwide and conducted by the Gallup organisation.

The survey also detected pessimism among exporters in Japan, South Korea and China over export orders in the next 12 months.
