COLOMBO, Feb 28: World champions Sri Lanka will meet Zimbabwe in the opening game of the three nation cricket tournament to be played in Sharjah in April this year, the cricket board said Friday, reports AP.

Pakistan is the other country taking part in the April 3-11 limited over tournament, said Dammika Ranatunga, chief executive of the cricket board.

Big bonus awaits 'em

JOHANNESBURG, Feb 28: South African breweries is offering prize money of 180,000 rand (41,200 dollars), the highest purse in South African cricket, for the Test series with Australia, reports AFP.

United Cricket Board of South Africa managing director Ali Bacher said amounts would be carried forward for drawn Tests, but there would be no prize money if the series was tied.

The winning team will receive 25,000 rand (5,720 dollars) per Test and the series winner will pick up 50,000 rand (11,442 dollars), each man-of-the-match will get 10,000 rand (2,288 dollars) and the player-of-the-series will get 25,000 rand (5,720 dollars).

"This is being done to further encourage positive Test match cricket because we are expecting big crowds," Bacher said.

Kirin Cup soccer in June

TOKYO, Feb 28: Japan will take on the national teams from Croatia and Bulgaria in their defence of the 100,000-dollar Kirin Cup football in June, the Japan Football Association said today, reports AFP. Japan will kick off the event on June 8 at the National Stadium in Tokyo, where they will play Croatia.

Croatia will meet Bulgaria on June 12 in Sendai with Japan challenging six-time World Cup participants Bulgaria on June 15 in Osaka.

Pay dispute

PARIS, Feb 28: France's national team players have protested at the 40,000 francs (8,000 dollars) per match they are being offered for their World Cup warm-up tournament in June, reports Reuters.

The players expressed their disappointment with the French federation's offer before Wednesday night's 2-1 home win over the Netherlands in a friendly international.

There will be further talks between the two parties when France meet Sweden at home of April 2 with the players looking for a higher sum for each appearance in the four-team Tournoi de France which also involves Brazil, Italy and England.

ENGLAND CHRONICLES

From Nizamuddin Ahmed in England

Word is that the West Indies Cricket Board is trying to stage the World Cup 2003 with a bonus proposal of holding the Cup every two years instead of the present four. That would be nice in a way but aren't we having too much of cricket already? All eyes are now anyway on the Caribbean with the first Test against Tendulkar's men beginning in a week's time at Sabina Park, Jamaica. It is true the West Indian officials are trying to persuade the ICC officials to hold the World Cup every two years and also true that they are serious about the 2003 event which has already been awarded to South Africa — England are hosts in 1999. So what is the WI Board planning? According to its secretary Andrew Sealy, it is "two-fold attack" before the ICC meets in Malaysia next month. "We feel that we are entitled to the World Cup 2003... but, outside of that fact, we are also keen to have the World Cup changed from every four years to every two years, and we are suggesting that 2001 is when the next World Cup could be held after 1999," says Sealy. Sneaky move, eh? The WICB in the meantime was "cautiously optimistic" that the final decision over the 2003 venue, to be decided at the full ICC meeting in London next July, will be in favour of the Calypso.

Also rich with a market value of £220 million. Their books are in some sort of shambles as they have incurred losses of more than half a million and they have borrowings of £4.5 million. Even then, they are keeping aside about a million for works on their stadium. Arsenal are valued at £230 million, Aston Villa at around £130 million, Newcastle United at about £200 million and Tottenham Hotspurs at just over £125 million. The two big Scottish sides Celtic and Rangers don't do bad either with market calls of £116 and £160 million respectively. Where do the clubs get all the money from? Well, they are all companies floated in the market, there is the TV revenue, gate receipts, merchandising operations, etc. It is now believed that more clubs may join the floatation scramble, encouraging their supporters to put their money where their mouths are.

Ernie Terrel was a friend of legendary heavyweight boxer Muhammad Ali, a name the former Cassius Clay took after converting to Islam. Terrel helped Ali to train for his two bouts with Liston in 1964. Once, after training, Ali drove Terrel to his house in his red Cadillac. They even shared the same room. They were pals. But when your friend hurts you, it can hurt real bad. Of all the people in the world Terrel should have known that Ali resented being called by his previous name of "slave" name. The Ali-Terrel title fight was held on February 6, 1967 at Houston. Before the contest, Terrel referred to the champion as "Clay." Ali was very hurt. But he had his way of getting back. During the fight, as each Ali punch landed on Terrel, the great Ali tauntingly asked, "what's my name?" Terrel was in no condition to reply and lost the 15-round contest on points.
