ICDDR,B confce begins

Call to launch campaign
against spread of STDs

The two-day sixth annual
scientific conference of
ICDDR,B began in the city yes-
terday with a call for launching
a vigorous campaign for pre-
venting the spread of sexually
transmitted diseases (STDs) in
the country, reports BSS.

Vice-Chancellor of Dhaka
University, Prof AK Azad
Choudhury inaugurated the
conference, dubbed as 'Ascon
vi', and urged all concerned to
give much more attention to
preventing the spread of such
diseases.

With the director of ICDDR,B
Prof Demissie Hebe in the
chair, the function was also ad-
dressed, among others, by ODA
representative Dr Mehtab Cur-
rey and representative of UN-
AIDS Dr Lisa Messersmith.

Dr Sarah Hawkes of
ICDDR,B gave the vote of
thanks while Dr Q Monir Islam
of WHO and Prof David Mabey
of London School of Hygiene
and Tropical Medicine gave lec-
tures on reproductive tract in-
fections and sexually trans-
mitted infections respectively.

Dr Choudhury stressed on
the need for creating wide-
spread awareness, particularly
among the women, about the
aftermath of such killer
diseases as HIV/AIDS.

"The real picture of HIV-
AIDS is yet to be discovered in
Bangladesh due to cultural bar-
riers," he said, urging the
ICDDR,B authorities to take up
a plan to pursue study in this
field as they have successfully
done on diarrhoeal diseases
over the decades.

A total of 52 scientific pa-
pers and 30 posters were pre-

sented at the conference by the
researchers of the centre, gov-
ernment of Bangladesh and
NGOs. As many as 225 delegates
and participants are attending
the conference, divided into ten
technical sessions.

In his welcome address, Prof
Demissie Hebe said reproduc-
tive tract infections and sexu-
ally transmitted infections
were incurring high morbidity
particularly among the women
— nearly 80 per cent — because
these two factors enhance the
transmission of HIV.

"The control of reproductive
tract infections is one of the
most important interventions
against HIV and AIDS, while it
is also important for the health
of women and their newborns,"
he said.

Hebe said the centre has re-
cently embarked upon setting
up of laboratory facilities to
test for HIV.

The two-day conference will
include presentations as well as
sharing of views on public
health and epidemiology, be-
havioral aspects, child health,
health services, developments
in diarrhoeal disease research
and the reproductive aspects.

Obituary

Shireen Akbar, Head of
Adult and Community Educa-
tion Unit of the Victoria and
Albert Museum, died in London
yesterday after a prolonged ill-
ness. She was 54, says a press
release.

Shireen Akbar was awarded
MBE in the Queen's Honours
List in 1996 in recognition of
the role she played to enable the
V&A to break new grounds in
widening links with the com-
munity, specially the South
Asian community.

For over 15 years, she organ-
ised a number of exhibitions on
non-traditional themes. 'Woven
Air' — an exhibition celebrating
the Kantha and Muslim tradi-
tions of Bangladesh was held at
the White Chapel Art Gallery,
London in 1988. In the same
year, she was commissioned by
the British Museum to make a
collection of rickshaw paint-
ings. She was also responsible
for setting up the Nehru Gallery
National Textile Project at the
Museum of Mankind in 1991. In
1994, she was invited to curate
the exhibition at the Fukoka
Art Museum of Japan.

Shireen Akbar was born in
Calcutta. She obtained a mas-
ters degree in English literature
from Dhaka University, and
completed advanced studies at
Cambridge University. She
worked for the Inner London
Education Authority from 1971
to 1988.
