Asma Kibria's solo show opens

A week-long solo painting exhibition by renowned artist Asma Kibria began at Shilpakala Academy in the city yesterday, reports BSS.

Prof Kabir Chowdhury inaugurated the exhibition as the chief guest while Syed Shamsul Haque was present as special guest.

Presided over by the Director General of Bangladesh Shilpakala Academy, Shamsuzzaman Khan, the inaugural session was addressed by Asma Kibria and director of the Academy, Subir Chowdhury.

Some 42 paintings by the artist, done at various phases of her career, are displayed at the exhibition.

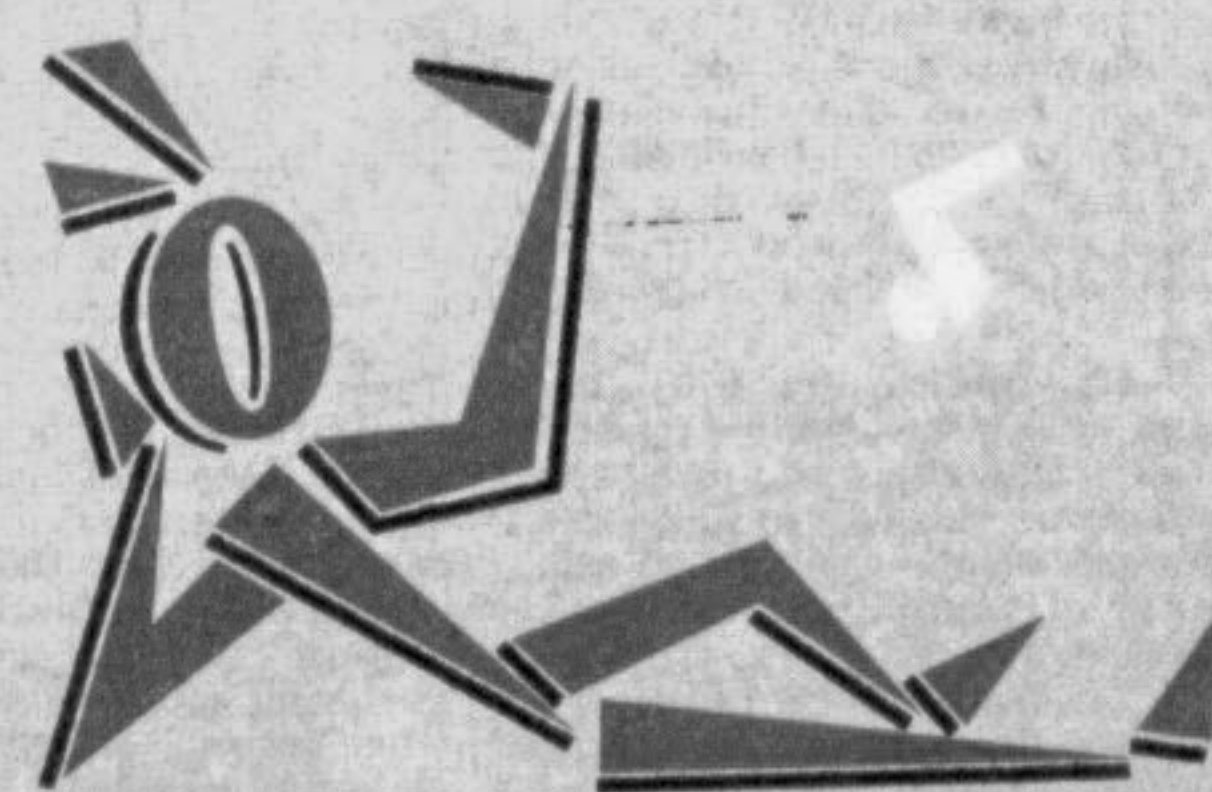
