Japan Open begins Apr 14

TOKYO. Mar 11: World minber one Pete Sampras, unbeaten this year, will defend the Japan Open title from April 14-20, reports AFP.

When the American won the 1993 Japan Open it gave him the world number one position for the first time. He won his third Japan Open title in 1996 and has never been beaten in Japan.

His main rivals will include 1996 Wimbledon champion Richard Krajicek of the Netherlands, Thomas Enqvist of Sweden, and three time Wimbledon champion Boris Becker of Germany. Other prominent players in-

clude top Britons Tim Henman and Greg Rusedski, and top doubles pair Todd Woodbridge and Mark Woodforde from Australia Asia's number one Leander

Paes, India's only medalist at the Atlanta Olympics, is also on the list, while Japan's top player Hsuzo Matsuoka re-

ceived a wild-card. Two-time Olympic doubles champion Mary Joe-Fernandez will lead the women's field with fellow-American Kimberly Po. Magdalena Maleeva of Bulgaria and Ai Sugiyama of Japan.



When the game got under way. West Indies captain Court-ney Walsh immediately declared at 241 for four.


However, India comfortably survived the last final session. scoring 99 runs for a loss of two wickets before the umpires abandoned play for good because of bad light.

Four-match ban on Ramos

TOKYO, Mar 11: Brazilianborn Ruy Ramos has been suspended for four tournament matches for insulting referees during an exhibition match last week, Japan's professional soccer league said Tuesday, reports

The 40-year-old Ramos of Kyoto Purple Sanga used "violent" Japanese words to protest against a ruling and then against his expulsion from the game with a red card, said a J-League official, speaking on condition of anonymity.

Purple Sanga, which finished last in the 16-team J-League last season, lost to Vissel Kobe 2-1 in the exhibition on March 2. Vissel Kobe is joining the league this season, which starts April 12.

The official said the suspension means Ramos will miss four of Purple Sanga's six J-League Nabisco Cup preliminary-round matches March 8-

Purple Sanga won the opening match against Avispa Fukuoka 1-0 last Saturday.

Ramos, who obtained Japanese citizenship in 1989. was a key player when Verdy Kawasaki won the J-League championship in 1993 and 1994. He transferred to Purple Sanga in May 1996.

STRASBOURG, France, Mar 11: French League Cup finalists Strasbourg began a new era today under the IMG sports management group which has bought a 49 per cent stake in the club for five million francs (870,000 dollars), reports Reuter.

The head of the French branch of American Mark Mc-Cormack's IMG organisation, former French number one tennis player Patrick Proisy, was due to take the reins as club president.

Jean-Francois Domergue, general manager of First Division rivals Paris St Germain, has been offered a similar position by Strasbourg and will make a decision this week.

Proisy, who is planning to build a championship winning side, said he wants to increase IMG's stake and invest 150 million francs (26 million dollars) in the club over the next five years.

He has declared striker David Zitelli, the First Division's leading scorer, and playmaker Pascal Nouma as not open to transfer bids and will also be looking to sign top players to strengthen the squad.

Strasbourg, fourth in the First Division standings, meet Bordeaux in the cup final in Paris on April 12.


