The terms and conditions of the contract and payment thereof will be subject in all respects to the terms and conditions of the said loan agreement. Sealed Bids are invited from the bonafide manufacturer/supplier for supply of a 250-300mm Cutter Suction Dredger (dismountable, transportable, multi-pontoon) of non self propelled type with pipes and floaters for KJDRP under ADB Loan No. 1289-BAN (SF) during the year 1996-97.

Rape cases behind most female murder incidents

PABNA, Mar 12: As many as 14 female of different age-groups were murdered under different circumstances during 1996 in the nine thanas of Pabna district. Of them, one was a child and two others were about eight and between fifteen years of age. The rest of the murdered were all adults — both married and unmarried.

Most of the murdered women were either killed after committing rape. Other were due to the non-satisfaction of the demand for dowry from the brides' side. Besides, poverty and family feuds are also learnt to have caused some of the tragic end of the women's life.

According to an official source one Anju, 17, was raped by Oli and Yakub at village Chachkia within Atgharia thana and there after, the two criminals allegedly poured acid into the secret part of the body of the girl. After long seven months, her body was exhumed when the matter came to the notice of the court.

In Atgharia thana, the be-headed body of one Rasheda Begum, 25, was recovered on March 20, 1996 from near Bahar Beel.

In yet another incident that occurred within the same thana, one Jasim Uddin Jhanta, 22, chopped the head of his step-mother Noor Banu, 32, and killed her on June 6 at village Nagdaha. The neighbours caught hold of the killer and handed him over to the police.

In village Manikhat under Sujanganar police station, Ban-

der Ali killed his two-month-old daughter by poisoning on July 23. Police, however, succeeded in bringing the father into book.

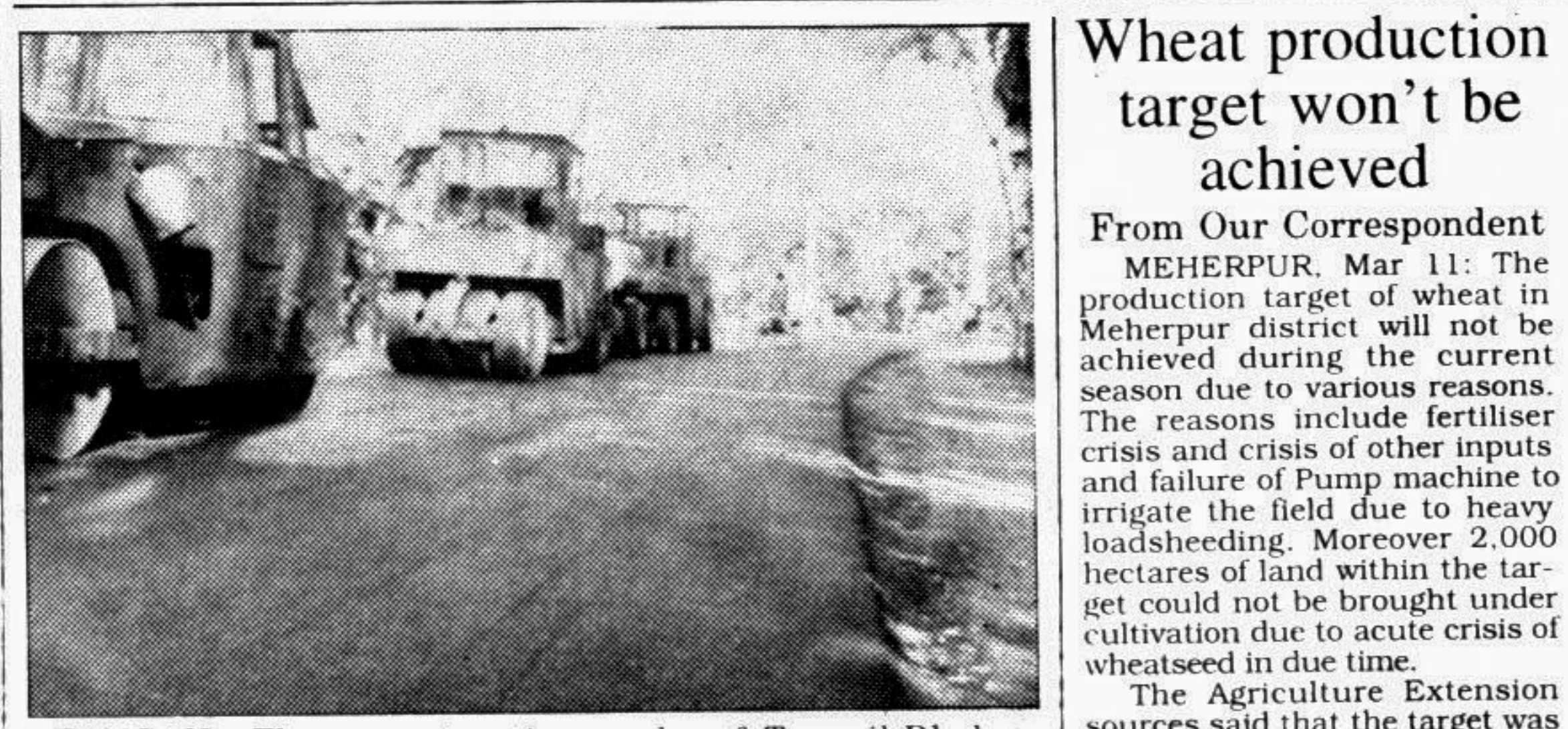
On June 12, Jakirunnesa, wife of Khidir Sheikh of village Noabari under the same thana was murdered. In this connection, police arrested three accused persons.

One Ismail of village Ah-madpur under the same thana demanded a dowry of Tk 12,000 from his father-in-law but when he failed to fulfil the demand, he killed his wife Maina. A case has been instituted in this connection.

In another incident, a male-child and the mother was murdered. One such occurrence took place on January 5 in village Bhadrakhola under Santhia thana when Abdus Samad of village Haripur took his ailing wife Mamta Begum to a room and gave her poison in the name of medicine. Soon after drinking the medicine, help-less Mamta Begum died.

In yet another incident of similar nature that took place in village Gopalpur under Santhia thana at dead of night on August 9, Mukul gave poison to his wife, Hasina who was suffering from illness. At once Hasina felt terrible stomach pain and started groaning. The husband fled Hasina died the next day in the evening in the Hospital where she was shifted for treatment.

Jyotsna Khatoun, a house-wife of village Bongram under Santhia thana was violated and

Brickfields pose a threat to environment

MEHERPUR, Mar 11: At least 5 thousand acres of land are being used in brick manufacturing in the district. It is reported that the increasing number of brickfields have become a threat to the environment as thousands of immature trees are being used as firewood in these fields.

A good number of flower and fruit bearing trees are also being burnt in these brickfields. On the other hand these lands are being deprived of cultivation of paddy, production of which is gradually decreasing resulting in its high price and inconveniences for the poor people who fail to purchase it within their capacity.

Moreover, the productivity of land has also decreased due to the adverse effect of brickfields in this area. Every year three to four crops are grown in this region through irrigation. Now it has become impossible to grow crops near the brick-

fields as the soil fertility has been declining gradually in the surrounding area of the brickfields. As a result, the farmers are having a tough time. Finding no other alternative they are compelled to mortgage their lands to the brickfields owners. On the order hand brickfield owners complained that they are compelled to use wood in manufacturing bricks as they cannot afford to buy coal at a fair price. They further alleged that the price of coal imported by the government is very high. So to keep brick prices stable they use wood which is much cheaper. On the other hand, the high cost of firewood has been causing immense hardship to the common people who use it in cooking. The price of bricks is increasing day by day on the plea of firewood getting costlier.

Incidents of kidnapping increasing

KUSHTIA, Mar 11: Incidents of kidnapping and later release of the kidnapped persons on payment of ransom have become rampant in remote villages of Mirpur thana during the last several months.

In fact the villagers have become hostages in the hands of terrorists who reign supreme in those areas and moving with sophisticated weapons. The peace loving youths are not being spared.


Either they are to obey their orders or to die.

General people can not speak anything about them in afraid of being killed. On February 11, Mir Kashem Ali, son of Faizuddin of village Khalmagura under Kursha union was kidnapped by the members of Purba Banglar Communist Party and after realising ransom money of Taka 20 thousand he was released the next day. On February 13 one Ismail son of Ali Mondol of the same village was kidnapped, but he was not released yet as they failed to pay the entire amount of ransom. The family sources said. The law enforcing agencies have utterly failed to check all these crimes and people of the area are living there in despair.
