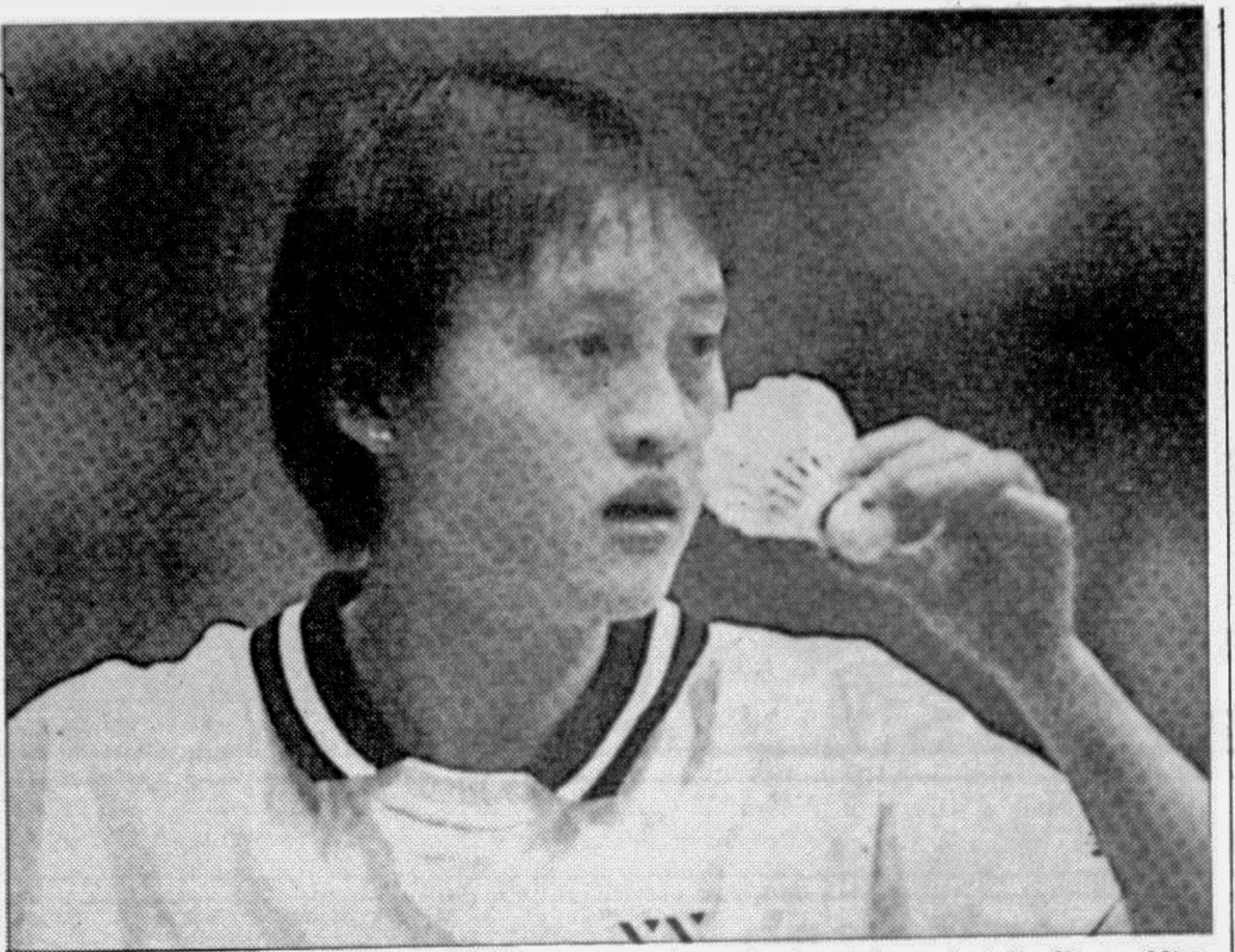

PORT-OF-SPAIN, Trinidad, Mar 15: An enterprising, unbeaten 71 by Roland Holder helped a shaky West Indies move to a moderate 239 for seven at close on the first day of the second Cable and Wireless cricket Test against India here Friday, reports AP.

Holder, in only his second Test, lifted the home team from the uncertainty of 169 for six with good support from the lower order.
