Schoolboy killed in crossfire in city

A school student was killed in a crossfire between two groups of alleged miscreant in Gandaria area of the city last night, reports BSS.

Relatives of the victim said, Sohel Mohammad, 14, a student of class eight of Gandaria High School sustained bullet injuries in his chest at about 8-30 pm when he was returning home from a coaching centre.

He was immediately taken to Dhaka Medical College Hospital (DMCH) where the attending doctor declared him dead. His body was kept at the morgue of the hospital for autopsy. The victim was the son of late Kalai Fakir of 51, Dhalkanagar Lane,


