LONDON, Mar 27: England opening batsman Nick Knight has declared himself fit to face Australia in the Ashes this summer, reports Reuter.

Warwickshire's Knight, 26 cracked a knuckle on his left hand while batting in the fourth one-day international against New Zealand in Auckland three weeks ago.

But speaking on Wednesday at the launch of a New England team sponsor, Knight said "I might miss the first week or two of the season, but I hope to be all right to play against Australia. The finger still looks a bit unpleasant but it feels fine."

Australia arrive in England in May for six Test matches and three one-day internationals.

Mobile telephone network Vodafone will back the England team from the start of next winter's West Indies tour and will invest 13 million pounds (21 million).

No Afro-Asian Nations' Cup this year

JOHANNESBURG, Mar 27 This year's Afro-Asian Nations' Cup competition between Saudi Arabia and South Africa has been cancelled, the Confederation of African Football (CAF) said on Tuesday, reports Reuter.

CAF cited a heavy schedule of qualifying matches for the World Cup and African Nations Cup finals next year, plus the fact that both countries will be playing in the Confederations' Cup in Riyadh in December, for the cancellation.

The Afro-Asian Nations' Cup is traditionally played every two years between the African champions and the winners of the Asian Cup.

Saudi Arabia won the Asian Cup competition in December 10 months after South Africa's success in the African Nations' Cup finals.

The Afro-Asian Nations' Cup has run since 1985, with Cameroon, Algeria, Japan. Nigeria and South Korea winning previous editions. The contest is traditionally decided over two legs.

South African Football Association officials said they were considering a Saudi offer to play a friendly international this year.

LISBON, Mar 27: Portugal's soccer coach Arture Jorge was attacked and knocked to the ground on Wednesday by Sporting striker Ricardo Sa Pinto apparently because the player was angry at being dropped from the national squad, reports Reuter.

Witnesses said that Sa Pinto turned up at the Lisbon training ground, where the nationalteam was preparing for Saturday's World Cup qualifier against Northern Ireland in Belfast, and demanded to speak to the trainer. Carlos Moia, a director of

Lisbon's Benfica club who was present at the ground, told that Sa Pinto than struck Jorge, knocking him down.

Jorge, who appeared unhurt in the attack, said later that the incident would have no effect on the preparation of the team which leaves for Belfast later on Wednesday.



NYON, Switzerland, Mar 27 Top referee Kurt Roethlisberger who took charge of the 1993 Champions' Cup final between Olympique Marseille and AC Milan, has been banned for life by UEFA for attempted bribery. reports AP.

According to soccer's European body Thursday, the Swiss official's actions concern the Champions' Cup game between Swiss club Grasshoppers and Auxerre of France in October 1996.

Vadim Zhuk of Belarus was the referee and UEFA said that Roethlisberger contacted the Swiss Club and asked if it would be interested in the referee not giving certain decisions against Grasshoppers. Roethlisberger said he was

friendly with the referee and it would be easy for him to arange it. UEFA said a sum of 70,000 dollars was suggested as compensation to Roethlisberger for doing it.

UEFA said Grasshoppers general manager Erich Vogel and Club president Romano Spadero informed UEFA what had happened and an investigation started.

Referee Zhuk is also under investigation to see if he was involved too the UEFA said he will not officiate as a FIFA referee until he has been cleared.
