It has also identified a number of securities houses including SES owned by Runa Alam of peregrin who had made delivery versus payment deals to attract small investors into the market and to hike prices.

The committee had also investigated into a number of newly floated companies and found major discrepancy in assets of Marks Engineer, Wonderland Toys and BD Luggage as shown in their prospectus.
