Mannan said here Thursday.

Mannan, who visited Saudi
Arabia last week, said the Saudi
government deported only
those who went there with
tourist or Omrah visa and were
overstaying.

Street Children's Day observed

The first ever Street Chil-
dren's Day was observed by the
Chinnamul Shishu Kishore
Sangstha (CSKS) through a day-
long programme inaugurated by
the Home Minister Rafiqul Is-
lam Bir Uttam yesterday.

The programme that began
at 9:30 am at the Alliance Fran-
caise in the city was attended
among others by Ambassador
Michael Drury, head of EC dele-
gation Dhaka, Simon Mollison,
country representative Save the
Children Fund (UK), Suhel
Ahmed, director general NGO
Affairs Bureau besides officials
and participants from the
CSKS.

Home Minister Rafiqul Is-
lam in his speech entered into a
dialogue with the street chil-
dren and offered them free ac-
cess to his residence if they do
not find any other place to re-
side.

Invited by the offer of dia-
logue six street children sponta-
neously came up with their
questions and described how
they were harassed by the po-
lice, by their employers and
even some times by their fami-
lies. They also narrated how the
circumstances brought them to
the streets forcing them out of
their homes.

More than 300 children
from four shelter homes and six
centres of the CSKS participated
in the programme.

The day long programme in-
cluded exhibition of painting
and handmade products by
street children, photographic
exhibition on lives and activi-
ties of street children in the
city, besides puppet show, magic
show, video film for the street
children. The exhibition will
remain open for public from to-
day to April 3, informed the or-
ganisers.

3 arrested for possessing illegal arms

Three persons including a
woman were arrested on
charges of possessing illegal
fire arms in a slum at Agargaon
