

**Smokers more vulnerable to drug addiction**

The smokers are more vulnerable to drug addiction than the non-smokers, a recent study by Social Science Research Council on drug addicts in Dhaka said, reports BSS.

It said among the total drug addicts surveyed under the study 98.28 per cent had smoking habits before developing drug addiction.

The study said 55.51 per cent addicts came from large families consisting of 6 to 12 members. Again 80 per cent had four to 12 siblings, it said.

The age of addicts ranged from 16 to 53 years but majority of them belong to the age group of below 30 years. It said 62.07 per cent of the addicts were unmarried and none were found to be divorced or separated. Although addicts had come from various occupational groups, majority were either businessmen themselves or sons of businessmen. The study said 55.51 per cent addicts were from large families consisting of 6 to 12 members. Again 80 per cent had four to 12 siblings, it said.

Government has taken programme for creating natural park and sanctuary for birds in the big khas digies of the country, reports BSS.

In the first phase the Durgasagar in Barisal, Jagannath in Comilla, Bijoy Sen in Feni and Nilshagar Dighi of Nilphamari will be brought under this programme in collaboration with the Ministry of Environment and Forest.
