Ruhul, accused in 50 murder cases, arrested

MEHERPUR, Apr 1: Gangni thana police have arrested Ruhul, one suspected to be a leader of Purba Banglar Communist Party and wanted in connection with 50 murder cases from village Kharampur of Gangni thana on Sunday.

On a tip-off, Meherpur, Gangni and Alamdanga thana police, in a combined raid, arrested Ruhul from a house of that village. Police also arrested another six persons along with him including two women. The arrested are: Panjab Ali, Sukur Ali, Rezaul, Azibar, Razia Khatun and Aleya Khatun.

Police recovered one SMG, one Chinese pistol, two loaded Magazines of SMG, ammunition and 12 rounds of pistol ammunition.

They were taken to Meherpur police station. Police said that Ruhul has been accused in 50 criminal cases in Meherpur, Gangni and Alamdanga police stations.

Drive against criminals has failed, says Khulna Range DIG

KHULNA: Apr 1: "The drive to improve law and order situation in 10 districts of Khulna Division has, in fact, failed to reach the goal. So the drive will continue for more than two months", said the Deputy Inspector General (DIG), Khulna range, Hadisuddin Ahmed.

According to an official source, a total of 62 persons were killed in separate incidents in 10 districts of the division during the first phase of the drive from January 1 to February 28. Two hundred incidents of rioting, kidnapping, extortion, rape and dacoities were committed during the same period, the source further said.

Police recovered, during the drive, a total of 60 pipe guns, two pistols, two guns, a large number of bullets and bombs from the city. Khanjahan Ali police station topped the list with the recovery of 26 firearms.

In the districts outside the metropolitan city, crimes are

allegedly common and political clashes are on rise. The armed operations of outlawed organisations have outplayed the strength of police.

Gunfight at GK ferry ghat

KUSHTIA, Apr 1: A clash ensued between two armed groups on both sides of the river Gori near GK ferry ghat on Sunday. Both the groups chased and counter chased each other and exchanged fire.

Eyewitnesses said that clashes took place in connection with demand of toll collection at the ferry ghat. Gun fire continued between the groups spreading panic in Haripur, a nearby village. As a result ferry services remained closed from 11 am to 3 pm. Further clash may take place at any time, eyewitnesses said. Police was informed and later in the afternoon police took position in the ferry ghat.
