Commonwealth CECs' workshop begins today

A four-day workshop for senior Commonwealth election officers in Asia and the Indian Ocean will begin in the city

from today, reports UNB.
Organised by the Commonwealth Secretariat in cooperation with the Bangladesh Election Commission, the workshop will consider ways of strengthening practical cooperation and improving organisa-

tion of elections. President Justice Shahabuddin Ahmed will inaugurate the workshop at Hotel

Sheraton at 9 am today. Sources said the officials will consider all the key phases in the electoral process preparations for elections, conducting of polls, vote counting and appraisal after elections in an effort to promote good practice in election manage-

Chief Election Commission ers and other senior electoral officials from India, Pakistan, Sri Lanka, Nepal, the Maldives, Malaysia, Mauritius, Pakistan and host Bangladesh will participate in the workshop.


