Deadlock at IU as Shibir enforces strike Sunday

ISLAMIC UNIVERSITY (Kushtia), Apr 7: The academic and administrative activities in Islamic University came to a dead lock on Sunday following a day-long strike on the campus enforced by the Islamic Chhatra Shibir.

During the strike-hours, all modes of transport excepting some three wheel vans were off the road on the campus. The Shibir activists, locked the main gate of the campus early in the morning. So the teachers, officers and employees could not come as most of them stay at Kushtia town or Jhenidha town due to accommodation problem on the campus. The presence of students were thin on the campus.

The examiners of several departments and the admission seekers who came to the viva-voce examination of UMA unit for the Department of Law and Muslim Jurisprudence went back home after waiting for sometime.

No classes and examinations were held and library, seminar rooms, offices of teachers and officers remained closed during the strike hours. However, the bank on the campus remained open for transactions.

The Islami Chhatra Shibir gave the call for strike to press home their 12-point charter of demands, including inquiry into alleged corrupt activities of Vice-Chancellor Professor Inam-ul-Haq and expulsion of the killers of M Aminur Rahman, a Shibir activist who was killed in a BCL-Shibir clash on September 26 last year.

About 200 policemen were posted around the campus and the adjoining areas to quell the situation.

Attack on Hasina's rail-march in 1994: JCD leader held

PABNA, Apr 7: In a pre-dawn swoop police Sunday arrested a local Jatityatabadi Chhatra Dal (JCD) leader on charge of attacking a rail-march of the then opposition leader Sheikh Hasina on September 23, 1994, says an UNB report.

Azizur Rahman Shaheed, general secretary of Ishwardi thana unit of JCD, was picked up from his residence at West Tengi at about 5 am.

At least 20 people were struck by bullets when armed terrorists opened fire on the train, carrying Sheikh Hasina and other Awami League leaders, as it entered the Ishwardi rail station from Khulna.

Police had filed a case with Ishwardi thana against 52 people in connection with the gunnatack. Twelve of the accused have so far been arrested.

Villager electrocuted

BARISAL, Apr 7: One person was electrocuted and died on the spot at village Tetla under Banaripara thana of Barisal district Sunday morning.

Witnesses said, Anwar Hosain, 25, a villager was electrocuted when he was cutting branches of a tree in his house at about 9 am on the day. The tree came in touch with a high voltage live electric wire of Rural Electrification Board (REB).

Diarrhoea takes serious turn in Pirojpur

BARISAL, Apr 7: Diarrhoea claimed two more lives - Rubel, 17, and Jesmin, 11, of Nadarula village affecting 42 persons in Bhandaria thana of Pirojpur district in 24 hours on Sunday. The situation in at least 4 thana areas of Pirojpur is alarming, according to local sources.

Diarrhoea has already claimed 7 lives affecting 438 persons in the sadar thana, Be-ton Baramachua and Tikikata villages of Bhandaria thana during the last one week. Acute crises of drinking water open latrines and unhygienic environment are the causes of diarrhoea, local people said.

According to the report received here till filing of this report the number of diarrhoea affected persons are: 16 in Mathbaria, 11 in Nazipur, 8 in Bhandaria and 7 in Kaukhali thana areas of Pirojpur district in 24 hours on Sunday.

Seeking justice

RAJBARI, Apr 7: A day labourer, Lalan Sardar is seeking justice and security of his life from the alleged killers of his 8 year-old son, Alamgir, reports UNB.

Narrating the agonising story of his fugitive life for the last several months, Lalan Sardar told journalists at the press club here, April 3, that the alleged killers had been threatening to kill him if he did not withdraw the police case.

He filed a complaint on August 17 last year with the Rajbari thana accusing 16 people of being involved in the murder of his son, Alamgir Sardar.

Lalan said a student of class 1 of Lakshuniko government primary school, Alamgir was kidnapped on his way to school on July 30, last year. The body was found in a sugarcane field much later.

On the basis of his complaint, police took two of the 16 accused into custody but released one of them on bail soon afterwards.

The 'other criminals are moving at large' and have been threatening to kill him, Lalan said. He cannot stay home at night for fear of life, he said.

Indefinite bus strike in 2 N-districts

NATORE, Apr 7: The inter-district bus service in Natore and Rajshahi districts has been stopped on Sunday for an indefinite period following a dispute over financial matters between bus workers and tempo-drivers at Baneshwar on Saturday night.

The Tempo Drivers' Association of Natore has enforced the strike which may continue for several days, said an official of Bangladesh Sarak Paribahan Group, Rajshahi unit.

As a result of the strike, no bus plied to Natore, Bogra, Rangpur and Pabna from Rajshahi on Sunday.

Sub-Inspector suspended

KISHOREGANJ, Apr 7: The Superintendent of Police (SP) of Kishoreganj, Chowdhury Ansanul Kabir, has suspended a Sub-Inspector of Karimganj thana on charge of dereliction of duty, reports UNB.

According to official sources, the sub-inspector, while he was in charge of Karimganj police station, deliberately delayed taking an FIR on dacoity and later tempered with the petitioner's complaint.

The owner of a Jewellery shop Md. Abul Hashem had gone to the police station on March 25 to lodge a case, on a dacoity case in which cash and jewellery worth about Tk. seven lakh had been looted. But the Sub-Inspector recorded the case on March 26, a day later and changed the written complaint of the owner.

The SP of Kishoreganj visited Karimganj on March 30 and the matter was brought to his notice. He suspended the Sub-Inspector on the spot. But no progress has so far been reported regarding the case.

Body of new born baby found

NARSINGDI, Apr 7: The body of a new born baby was recovered from a ditch at Ajketola village in Shibpur thana on Friday, reports UNB.

Police said, the decomposed body of the infant was found by the labourers who were re-excavating the ditch (lake) at Badal Estate in the village. It was wrapped in polythene bags.

Police said, they had no report of any missing baby and the villagers have no information about any baby born in the area.

Attack on journalists in Pabna: Silent procession demanding arrest of attackers

PABNA, Apr 7: Local newsmen brought out a silent procession in the town and submitted a memorandum to the Deputy Commissioner Sunday, protesting Wednesday's attack on two of their colleagues, reports UNB.

They alleged that the activists of pro-Awami League Chhatra League roughed up Shushil Tarader, the local correspondent of the Daily New Nation, and Abdul Matin Khan of the Daily Banglar Bani on Wednesday afternoon.

In their memorandum, the processionists demanded exemplary punishment and arrest of the attackers by April 15.

The procession was brought out from the local press club and terminated at the DC office with submission of the memorandum.

One falls from bus roof-top, dies in Ctg

CHITTAGONG, Apr 7: A devotee of Majibhandari Darbar Sharif died after he fell from the roof of a Noakhali-bound bus near Zorarganj Bazar in Mirsarai thana Sunday, reports UNB.

Police said the unidentified man aged about 25 fell down while singing a religious song on the roof of the bus along with other devotees at 1:30 pm. He died on the spot.

The body was taken to Mirsarai thana. Police seized the bus, but the driver fled the scene.

Bus passenger killed

NARSINGDI, Apr 7: A bus passenger was killed and 15 others were injured in an accident on Dhaka-Sylhet highway at Panchodona bazar in Sadar thana on Sunday, reports UNB.

Witnesses said, the road mishap occurred when a Ghorashal bound minibus from Dhaka was hit by another bus from behind at 5:30 pm.

The passenger, Badrul Alam (37) of Ichhakhali village of Polash thana, died on the spot. Of the injured passengers, Montu (22), Arman (26) and Kamal (32) were admitted to Sadar Hospital.

The drivers of the two buses left the scene after the accident. A case was filed with Sadar police.

12 hurt in clash over toll collection

SYLHET, Apr 7: At least 12 people have been injured in a clash between two groups of people in the town over toll collection, reports UNB.

The clash between shopowners and extortionists erupted on March 31 when toll collectors ransacked a hotel in Ambarakhana of the town.

Extortionists fired one shot in the air and fled the scene as soon as police arrived there.

Burichong police said, BDR personnel led by Company Commander Amjad Hossain arrested Khandkar Yunus Ali, Mohammad Harmuj Ali and Nayon Miah when they were cheating innocent people of the area identifying themselves as army officers.

Being informed, company commander of Sankuchal border out post Amjad challenged and arrested them from the union parishad. Later, they were handed over to Burichong thana.
