Among them, some apprised her about their problems like seizure of property by others, some sought financial assistance for treatment, while some came merely to pay a courtesy call and exchange good wishes with the Prime Minister.

Tasmin Chowdhury Bonni, whose desire to meet the Prime Minister was reported in a section of the press, got the opportunity to meet Hasina first.

Bonni, a student of class II from RK Mission Road, presented her doll to the Prime Minister, who hugged her and accepted the gift with great affection.

ABM Khurshed Alam, a freedom fighter and ex-foreign office personnel at the time of War of Liberation, presented the Prime Minister an original mini national flag of the Mujibnagar government and a history booklet on the War of Liberation.

The Prime Minister became emotional when she came to learn from Nizamuddin of Sonagazi under Feni district the tragic tale of how one of his legs were cut off by political opponents.

Rijia Begum came from Narayanganj to seek the Prime Minister's intervention to rescue her brother, who has been kidnapped by some miscreants. The PM ordered forthwith enquiry into the case and directed the authorities concerned to ensure justice to Rijia.

Sakina Begum came to seek financial help for the treatment of her daughter abroad. The PM directed concerned persons to look into the treatment of her daughter.



British Council introduces new English courses

The British Council, Dhaka, has recently introduced a variety of courses for non-English speaking people of Bangladesh.

The British Council Training Centre which is currently educating some 1,500 people per year, expects further demand for its English education and training programmes.

In a press conference on Wednesday, Charlie Walker, Teaching Centre Manager, and David Phelan, Head of Courses, said that course fees have also been reduced sufficiently to help moderate income group learners to take part in the courses.

The General English Programme is now divided into ten levels, ranging from beginners to advanced level. Besides, a young learners course for children aged between 7-14 is also being provided.

"Our general English course and the young learners course are considered to be the most popular," said Charlie Walker. He said the timing of the courses have been made flexible and liberal for the convenience of the participants.

The British Council officials said that the course fee for the International English Language Testing System (IELTS) will remain fixed at Taka 9,200 now. IELTS is an exam for people aiming to study in the UK, Australia and New Zealand.

The Council is also planning to introduce courses for journalists on writing reports in the near future.


