

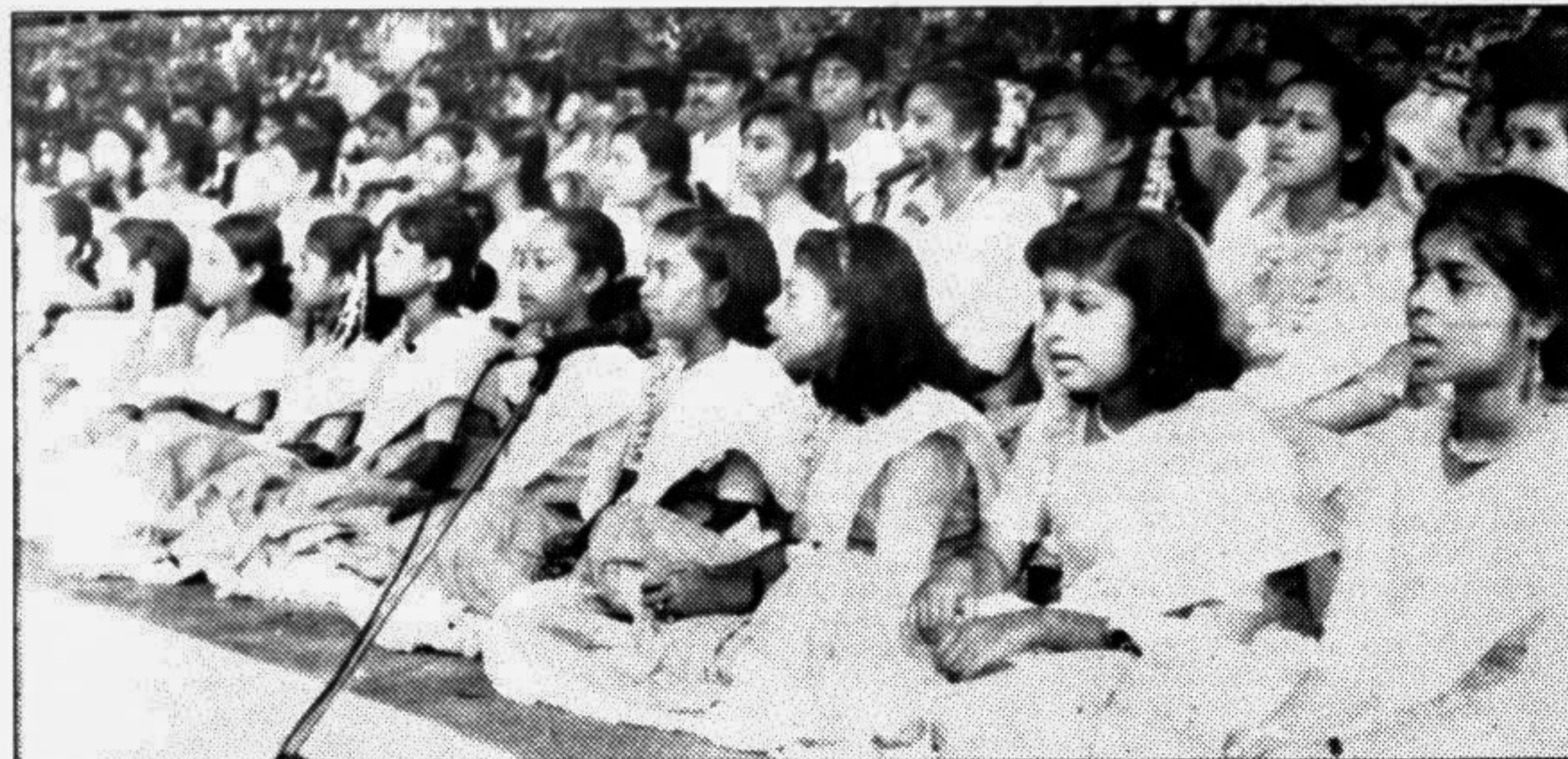
Singapore FM calls on Khasru

Clinton sends Eid greetings to Hasina

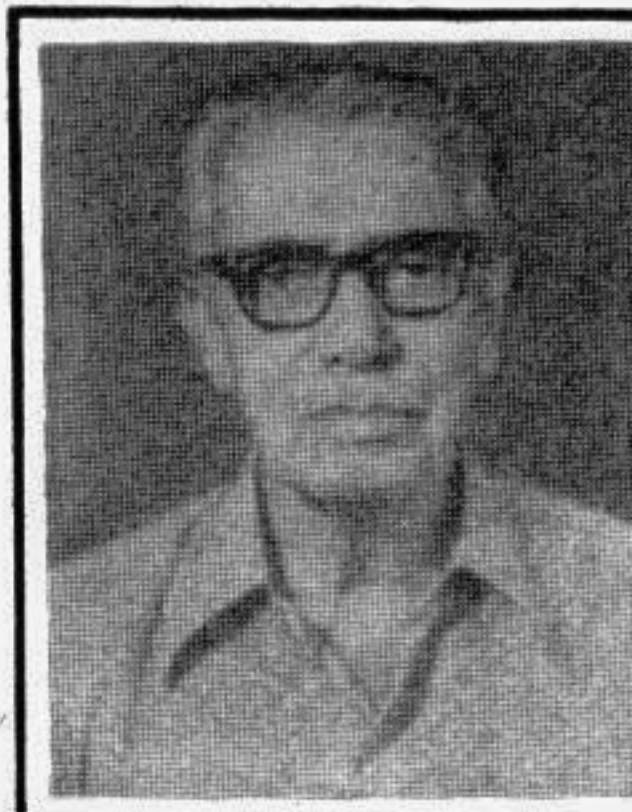
