
#### NU law teachers' training course begins

## New laws for uplift of urban poor urged

Speakers at the inaugural session of a 3-day workshop yesterday underscored the need for promulgation of new laws for bringing a positive upliftment in the life of the urban poor who are a part and parcel of the city life, reports BSS.

They also stressed the need for bringing a change in the mentality, approach and realisation of the national and city planners who, hitherto, were always elite-biased.

They said that the poor are neither problems, nor liabilities in the city but a very important tool for urban development. "A mare work-stoppage by the urban poor for a single day may bring a total halt in the entire city life," they ob-

Held at the seminar room of Bangladesh Management De-velopment Centre (BMDC), the three-day workshop on "Advocacy campaign planning" was organised by the Coalition for the Urban Poor (CUP).

Representatives from thirty non-governmental organisations are taking part in the workshop, which is conducted by eminent advocacy experts and modern communication scientists of the country.

Chief of the Institute for Development Policy Advocacy (IDPA) Mahbubul Karim attended the workshop as chief guest while Director of the Trip Trust Shaheen Anam and Executive Director of CDS Omar Faruque Chowdhury took part in the inaugural session as special guests.

Chaired by CUP President Shahabuddin Ahmed, the session was also addressed by Khurshidul Islam of GSS, CUP coordinator Shirin Banu and CUP vice-president Khandkar Rebaka Sunyat.

Mahbubul Karim called for launching united and integrated efforts by both governmental and non-governmental organisations to combat both rural and urban poverty and thus achieve meaningful and sustainable development for poverty alleviation. Dwelling at length on various comprehensive aspects of advocacy, a recent phenomenon in the country in development thrust, Karim termed it as an effective tool to popularise the idea and vision of the government as well as other organisations en-gaged in eradicating poverty and hunger from society.

#### Faezul opens workshop

### Make people aware about environmental pollution

State Minister for Jute and Textiles A K Faezul Huq yester-day underscored the need for creating public awareness about environmental pollution and its harmful effects on the life of the people, reports BSS.

He said jute is environmentfriendly but the textile industries are polluting the envi-ronment. He said this industrial pollution could be minimised by improving knowledge and awareness of the owners and management personnel.

The state minister was speaking as the chief guest at the inaugural session of a twoday national workshop on "Pollution minimisation in Small and Medium Enterprises (SMEs) for enhancing its competitiveness."

Jointly organised by Bangladesh Small and Cottage Industries Corporation (BSCIC) and the Dhaka Chamber of Commerce and Industry (DCCI), the workshop is being held at the DCCI auditorium with financial and technical assistance from Technonet Asia.

Owners of small and medium industries, concerned government officials, representatives of industrial financing institutions, different trade forums, development agencies, donor countries and agencies, environmental NGOs and professional bodies are taking part in the workshop.

The inaugural session was also addressed by Environment and Forest Secretary Ahbab Ahmad, DCCI President A S M Quasem, BSCIC Technical Director Rabindranath Tribedi. officer-in-charge of Technonet Asia Shahabuddin Faruque and Senior Vice-President of DCCI

Ashraf Ibn Noor.

Environment Secretary Ahbab Ahmad regretted that even highly-educated citizens were not aware of the gravity and danger of the environmental problems.

DCCI President Quasem said products of our small and cottage industries are competing in the developed countries and that is environmental issues were being raised to disturb our competitiveness.

Technonet representative Shahabuddin Faruque said intensive educational programme was needed to make the owners and management of small and medium industries aware of pollution.




