

Foreman keeps on ticking

Foreman, 48, stepped into the ring for the 80th time and took his record to 76-4 with 60 knockouts.

But he has failed to stop any of his opponents of the last 30 months inside the distance, and he was unable to hurt a plodding Savarese on Saturday.

One judge saw the bout 114-113 in favour of Savarese, the two others had Foreman winning 115-112 and 118-110. Foreman weighed in for the

12-round bout - in which he retained the world heavyweight crown of the obscure World Boxing Union - at 253 pounds (116

It was a far cry from Foreman's glory days. He won his first world title in 1973 with a stunning second-round over Joe Frazier. He lost it to Muhammad Ali the following year in Zaire.

Foreman, who defeated Michael Moorer to regain the International Boxing Federation and World Boxing Association titles in 1994, gave up both rather than fight designated challengers.


