

Tense situation prevailing at Fenchuganj Fertiliser Factory

SYLHET, May 4: A tense situation is prevailing in the Fenchuganj Fertiliser Factory threatening suspension of production any moment, reports UNB.

According to sources, the undesirable situation follows a series of incidents in the factory since September last year.

A rift between the president and general secretary of the Employees Association took a violent turn last month when rival supporters attacked and counter-attacked each other. On one incident, the personnel manager was assaulted by a worker on April 17.

Some workers were suspended in this connection and police cases were instituted by both sides.

Rivalry between the president and secretary aggravated over appointment of some employees in the factory.

A section of the employees accused the Managing Director of political favouritism in the matter of recruitment.

The Managing Director has been transferred elsewhere but this action has angered the other section of the employees and workers.

General workers have alleged serious mismanagement and urged the authorities to resolve the crisis for the sake of uninterrupted operation of the oldest fertiliser factory of the country.

Property worth Tk 1cr burnt to ashes in 3 fire incidents

MOULVIBAZAR, May 4: Property worth about Taka one crore was burnt to ashes in three separate fire incidents at Kulaura, Nabigonj and Auskandi under Moulvibazar and Hobigonj districts recently.

According to witnesses and police sources, a devastating fire from a carelessly handled open lamp (Kupri) soon engulfed the 15 houses at Uttar Sadipur village under Kulaura thana. Five people, including a 10-month old baby, was injured in the fire incident.

Local people after frantic efforts brought the fire under control. The estimated loss is about Taka 10 lakh, the source said.

Another report from Nabigonj thana headquarters under Hobigonj district says 22 shops were gutted in a devastating fire on April 29 at Nabigonj bazar. On a telephonic information the fire-service from Moulvibazar rushed to the spot and extinguished the fire.

As the fire originated from a tea stall of the bazar. Property worth Taka more than 80 lakh was destroyed in this fire incident, police sources said.

In another incident valuable worth about Taka 50 thousand were gutted in a fire incident at Auskandi Bazar of Nabigonj thana.

Showcause notice on 2 Moulvibazar newsmen

MOULVIBAZAR, May 4: The Assistant Judge of Moulvibazar has imposed an interim injunction order and issued a showcause order on two journalists of the district headquarters on April 29 this year.

According to the injunction order, Syed Motiur Rahman Sani, a correspondent of Bangladesh Betar and Sarwar Ahmed, another correspondent of the Bangladesh Patrika will refrain from all activities in the name of Moulvibazar Press Club and its committee for an interim period. The court also directed them to showcause before the court within seven days as to why they would not refrain from all activities in the name of the aforementioned press club permanently.

M A Salam, newly elected Secretary of Moulvibazar Press Club submitted a petition before the court seeking an injunction order on two journalists. In his petition to the court, the secretary of the press club mentioned that journalists Motiur Rahman Sani and Sarwar Ahmed both working in the district headquarters recently made a publicity through the press that they have formed another executive committee for the press club. Such act of two journalists was specific violation of laws and by-laws of the existing constitution of the press club.

After hearing on the petition the Assistant Judge issued the above-mentioned orders.

It may be mentioned here, Moulvibazar Press Club is a registered organisation under the 'Society Act'. The executive committee of the press club was elected unopposed with Rodhika Mohon Goswami and MA Salam as president and secretary respectively and later it was approved in the Annual General Meeting which was held on April 19.

But on the same day of the Annual General Meeting, four general members of the press club formed another committee of the club with Syed Motiur Rahman Sani and Sarwar Ahmed as president and secretary respectively.

It is also alleged that during formation of this committee led by Motiur and Sarwar, the constitutional rules were not followed. They included the major portion of office-bearers who have no primary membership of the press club. They formed the committee without declaration of election schedule under the existing constitution of the press club. According to their publicity through press, they have also locked out the gate of the press club building.

Four wanted criminals held

Four get 10-yr RI for possessing arms

JHENIDAH, May 4: Four accused were awarded 10 years rigorous imprisonment (RI) by the court in separate arms cases recently, according to court sources.

Ibrahim and Basudev both of village Shibnagar in Kaliganj thana of the district were given the punishment by the Assistant Sessions Judge of Jhenidah, Kabita Khanam. On May 18 in 1996 Kaliganj thana police arrested both the accused and recovered a country made pipegun.

In another judgement Md Saiful Islam, Additional District and Sessions Judge awarded 10 years' RI to Matanz Begum alias Josna and her brother Azizul of Wirelesspara in Jhenidah sadar thana.

According to prosecution police recovered a revolver, one round of bullet and a knife from the house of Josna on August 5 in 1995.

10 hurt as hotel workers clash in Rangpur

RANGPUR, May 4: At least 10 people were injured in a clash between two rival groups of hotel workers on Thursday here, reports UNB.

Of the injured, Robin, 25, Jahir, 28, Mojibor, 27, and Jabbar, 30 were admitted to Rangpur Medical College Hospital in a critical condition.

The clash erupted when rival hotel workers brought out two separate processions marking the May Day confronted at Jahaj Company crossing in the town at about 10 am.

Both the groups attacked each other with lethal weapons and brick bats.
