

### WC qualifier China trounce

Turkmenistan ASHGABAT, Turkmenistan, May 5: China rode two first half goals by Peng Weiguo to a 4-1 victory over Turkmenistan in World Cup soccer qualifying competition on Sunday, reports

The victory left China tied with Tajikistan, a 4-0 winner over Vietnam on Sunday, atop the four-nation Group 8 after the first day of play.

Turkmenistan, which carned a surprising 2-2 draw with the Chinese at the Asian Games three years ago, outplayed the visitors for the first 25 minutes but missed on two scoring opportunities by Khakhu Gogaladze.

China broke through in the 27th minute when Li Ming passed from the left side and Peng beat goalkeeper Alexander Korobko. Peng scored again 12 minutes later.

The Chinese dominated the second half and got goals from Gao Feng in the 79th minute and Li Bing in 82nd. Turkmenistan averted a shutout with a 90th-minute score by Jumadur dy Meredov.

### 397-member Jap squad for Pusan

TOKYO, May 5: A total of 397 Japanese athletes and officials will join the second East Asian starting this weekend in southern South Korean city of Pusan with other eight countries and regions, reports AFP.

"It will be a tough competition, because the East Asian countries include top Asian countries China and South Korea," said Hironoshin Furuhashi, head of the Japanese Olympic Committee, at a ceremony held in Tokyo Monday.

"I really hope that our athletes are able to make it a big stepping stone to the Asian Games in Bangkok next year and the Sydney Olympic Games in 2000," Furuhashi added.

Some 250 athletes and officials attended the team forming ceremony, a day before the Japanese squad flies to Pusan Tuesday morning.

Japanese team leader Yoshiro Okai said their target is to win "At least more gold medals than we took in Shang-

In Shanghai in 1993, Japan won 25 gold, 37 silver and 55 bronze medals to take second place to China, the winners of 105 gold medals, South Korea won 23 gold, 28 silver and 40 bronze medals for third spot.

RIO DE JANEIRO, May 5: Sao Paulo continued their amazing revival by beating arch-rivals Palmeiras 4-2 in the Sao Paulo championship at the weekend, reports Reuter. The win followed an 8-1 de-

molition of Juventus in the same tournament last Sunday and a 5-2 hammering of American on Thursday. Nineteen-year-old striker Dodo, who scored hattricks in

each of the previous games, added two more as Sao Paulo recovered after going behind early on. The result made Sao Paulo, who have suddenly found their

goalscoring touch after a mediocre start, mathematically sure of a place in the four-team final play-off, along with Corinthins, who guaranteed their place in midweek.
